

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(SANDROCK ROAD, ROYAL TUNBRIDGE WELLS)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
(AMENDMENT No 3)
ORDER 2011**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of their powers and under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of the Schedule 9 to the Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (thereinafter called "the Act") and as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 Part 6 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, has made the following Order:-

Citation and Commencement

1. Exemptions provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for disabled badge holders, for the loading and unloading of goods, for enabling work to be carried out in or adjacent to the road and for emergency service vehicles.
2. This Order may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (Sandrock Road, Royal Tunbridge Wells) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment No 3) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on the 28th November 2011.
