### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD METROPOLITAN (MERCHANT GATE MULTI STOREY CAR PARK) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2016

The Council of the City of Wakefield (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 Act, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Specific Parking Area) (Metropolitan District of Wakefield) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with all those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby make the following Order:-

### PART I CITATION AND DEFINITIONS

- This Order shall come into operation on the thirteenth day of June 2016 and may be cited as "The Council of the City of Wakefield (Merchant Gate Multi Storey Car Park) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2016".
  - (2) For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one parking place where the context requires it and any definition by reference to a statutory or other legislative provision shall include reference to any amending provision.
  - 2. In the following provisions of this Order:-
    - "authorised officer" means anyone duly authorised to act on behalf of the enforcement authority for the purposes of the supervision and enforcement of this Order;
    - "Badges Regulations" means the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);
    - "Band" as set out in Column 2 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order means the charge payable, as specified in Column 3 of that Schedule in respect of the location, as specified in Column 1 of the said Schedule and is represented by a letter specified in Column 2 of that Schedule;
    - "charging hours" means the period on the days specified in Column 4 of the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules to this Order during which a charge may be payable;
    - "civil enforcement officer" has the same defined in Article 76(1) of the Act of 2004;
    - "disabled persons badge" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2 of the Badges Regulations;

- "disabled persons vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;
- "driver" in relation to a vehicle left in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;
- "enforcement authority" means the Council of the City of Wakefield;
- "entry barrier" means any apparatus installed to facilitate the issuing of a numbered entry ticket on arrival at the parking place having been specially approved by the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under Sections 35(3B) of the Act of 1984;
- "entry ticket" means a ticket dispensed at the entry barrier point by the enforcement authority or on the enforcement authority's behalf in accordance with the operating methodology applicable from time to time;
- "leaving" and "left" (in the context of the leaving of a vehicle in the parking place or of a vehicle being left in the parking place) means parking such vehicle or allowing such vehicle to come to rest in that parking place (other than for so long as is necessary only to allow a passenger to board or alight from the vehicle), irrespective of whether or not the driver remains with the vehicle;
- "motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;
- "notice to owner" means a notice served under regulation 19 of the Civil Enforcement Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007
- "owner" in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;
- "parking bay" means a space within the parking place marked out by surface markings to accommodate a single vehicle;
- "parking charge" means the amounts specified in column 3 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order;
- "parking place" means any area specified in Column 1 of the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules to this Order provided by the Council in pursuance of Section 32(1)(a) of the Act of 1984;
- "pay on foot ticket machine" means any apparatus to facilitate the operation of the parking place, such apparatus having been approved by the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under Section 35(3) or 46(2)(a) of the 1984 Act and situated in the vicinity of the parking place to which it relates.
- "penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" has the meaning given by section 92 of the 2004 Act;
- "penalty charge notice" has the meaning given by Regulation 8 of the General Regulations; "permit" means a parking voucher issued by the enforcement authority or on the enforcement authority's behalf from time to time;
- "relevant position" insofar as it relates to the display of a disabled persons badge has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the 2000 Regulations;
- "relevant position" insofar as it relates to the display of an entry ticket/permit means:-

- (a) if the vehicle is fitted with a front windscreen the entry ticket/permit is exhibited thereon facing outwards on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen; or
- (b) if the vehicle is not fitted with a front windscreen the entry ticket/ticket or permit is exhibited conspicuously on the front of the vehicle;

"the 2000 Regulations" means the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

### PART II USE OF PARKING PLACE

### 3. Use of Parking Place

- a) Every parking place shall, unless the prior written consent of the enforcement authority has been obtained, be used subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article 4 of this Order and are capable at all times of vacating the parking place under their own means of mechanical propulsion, in such manner and subject to such conditions and restrictions as are specified in relation to the parking place.
- b) The driver of a vehicle using the parking place during the charging hours shall on arrival at the parking place;
  - Obtain an entry ticket from the entry barrier point at the parking place;
     or
  - ii. Insert or present a permit at the entry barrier point at the parking place.
- c) Before leaving the parking place the driver of a vehicle must comply with the operating methodology applicable from time to time.

### 4. Classes of Vehicles

Unless prior written consent of the enforcement authority is obtained and subject to such conditions and restrictions as are specified in relation to the parking place in the relevant Articles and Schedules to this Order:-

- (1) Vehicles using the parking place must be able to park wholly within a parking bay.
- Where parking bays are marked out for disabled use, any such parking bay within a parking place specified in Column 1 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order may only be used by a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge and an entry ticket/permit valid for that parking place.

- (3) Where parking bays are marked out for disabled use, any such parking place specified in Column 1 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order may only be used by a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge.
- (4) Where parking bays are marked out for motor cycle use, any such parking bay may only be used by a motor cycle.

### 5. Penalty Charge

- (1) Save as provided in Paragraphs (3) and (5) of this Article and insofar as a vehicle is left in the parking place the driver thereof shall pay the penalty charge on each and every day on which the vehicle is left in accordance with the following provisions of this part of the Order.
- (2) Save as provided in Paragraph (3), (4) and (5) of this Article the penalty charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be Band Y of the Sixth Schedule to this Order and the penalty charge shall be paid by the driver of the vehicle.
- (3) The driver of any vehicle left in a parking place, as specified in Column 1 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order shall be exempt from payment of the penalty charge if an entry ticket/permit, valid for that parking place, is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle.
- (4) The driver of any vehicle left in a parking place, as specified in Column 1 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order, shall be exempt from payment of the penalty charge; PROVIDED THAT such vehicle does not exceed the maximum period of permitted stay specified in Column 3 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
- (5) The driver of any vehicle left in a parking place at any time shall be exempt from payment of the penalty charge if the vehicle complies in all respects with the conditions and restrictions contained in Article 11 and any other requirement of this Order as to the conditions and restrictions of use of the parking place.
- (6) The driver of any vehicle exceeding the maximum period of permitted stay specified in Column 3 the Fourth Schedule to this Order may pay the penalty charge using the pay on foot ticket machine. If payment of the penalty charge is not made a penalty charge notice will be issued by the civil enforcement officer/authorised officer before being able to leave the parking place.

### 6. Parking Charge

- a) The parking charge for a vehicle left in a parking place during the charging hours shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be as specified in Column 3 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order;
- b) If the entry ticket/permit used in repect of a parking place as specified in the First, Second and Fourth Schedules to this Order is lost, damaged or defaced and cannot

- be used for payment of the parking charge a new entry ticket/permit will be generated;
- c) If payment of the parking charge cannot be made then the driver will be issued with a release form before leaving the car park and an invoice for the required amount issued at a later date.

### 7. Maximum Period of Stay

The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting (if any) specified in Column 3 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order in relation to that parking place.

### 8. <u>Exhibition of Entry Tickets/Permits</u>

The driver of a vehicle left in a parking place as specified in Column 1 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order shall attach an entry ticket/permit in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and shall cause the said entry ticket/permit to be exhibited in that position at all times while the vehicle is left in the parking place.

### 9. Notice of Charges

- (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in Column 1 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order and;
  - (a) no entry ticket/permit is displayed on that vehicle in accordance with Article 5 of this Order; or
  - (b) is left in such a position that it does not comply with the provisions in Article 11 of this Order or otherwise contravenes any other requirement in Part III of this Order as to the conditions and restrictions of use of the parking place; or
  - (c) fails to observe any specific restrictions on use specified in Column 2 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order;
  - a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer shall attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice informing the driver that the penalty charge prescribed in Article 5(1) is required to be paid.
- (2) If a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in Column 1 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order and is left in such a position that it does not comply with the provisions in Article 12 of this Order or otherwise contravenes any other requirement in Part III of this Order as to the conditions and restrictions of use of the parking place a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer shall attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice informing the driver that the penalty charge prescribed in Article 5(1) is required to be paid.

- (3) If a vehicle is parked in the area specified in Column 1 of the Fifth Schedule a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer shall attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice informing the driver that the penalty charge prescribed in Article 5(1) is required to be paid.
- (4) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge has been incurred it shall be the duty of a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer (in attaching a notice to the vehicle in a conspicuous position) to specify the following particulars and information:-
  - (a) the date and time on which the notice is served;
  - (b) the name of the enforcement authority;
  - (c) the registration mark of the vehicle involved in the alleged contravention;
  - (d) the date and time at which the alleged contravention occurred;
  - (e) the grounds on which the civil enforcement officer/authorised officer serving the notice believes that a penalty charge is payable;
  - (f) the amount of the penalty charge;
  - (g) that the penalty charge must be paid not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the penalty charge notice was served;
  - (h) that if the penalty charge notice uis paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served, the penalty charge will be reduced by the amount of any applicable discount
  - (i) the manner in which the penalty charge must be paid; and
  - (j) that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days referred to in subparagraph (g), a notice to owner may be served by the enforcement authority on the owner of the vehicle.
- (5) When a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Article, no person not being the driver of the vehicle or person duly authorised by the enforcement authority shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver. A person contravening any provision of this paragraph shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
- officer has cause to believe a penalty charge has been incurred, prevents the affixing of a notice (as referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article) to the vehicle by such civil enforcement officer/authorised officer (either by driving the vehicle out of the parking place or otherwise), the enforcement authority shall serve notice on the person whom they believe to be the owner or registered keeper of the vehicle, requesting information as to the identity of the driver of the vehicle at the time when the penalty charge was incurred and upon receipt of such information, the

enforcement authority shall serve the notice which requires the penalty charge to be paid (as referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article) on that person (or on any other person who it comes to light may have been the driver of the vehicle at that time), by first class post at the last known address of that person.

- (7) When a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Article, no person not being the driver of the vehicle or person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.
- (6) If the driver of a vehicle in respect of which a Parking Attendant has cause to believe a standard charge has been incurred, prevents the affixing of a notice (as referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article) to the vehicle by such Parking Attendant, the Council shall serve notice on the person whom they believe to be the registered keeper of the vehicle, requesting information as to the identity of the driver of the vehicle at the time when the standard charge was incurred and upon receipt of such information, the Council shall serve the notice which requires the standard charge to be paid (as referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article) on that person (or on any other person who it comes to light may have been the driver of the vehicle at that time), by first class post at the last known address of that person.

### 10. Indication by Entry Ticket/Permit

If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place, as specified in Column 1 of the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order, during the charging hours and a entry ticket/permit is not exhibited on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of this Order it shall be presumed that the vehicle is parking in contravention of the requirements specified in Article 5(3)of this Order.

### 11. Manner of Standing in Parking Place

- (1) Every vehicle left in the parking place shall stand wholly within a parking bay unless the prior consent of the Council has been obtained.
- (2) A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking place shall take all necessary steps to ensure that the vehicle stands in accordance with Paragraph (1) of this Article and also adheres to all other requirements of this Order as to the conditions and restrictions of use of the parking place.

### 12. Alteration of Position of Vehicle in Parking Place

Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 11 of this Order a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

### 13. <u>Movement of Vehicles in Parking Places in Emergencies</u>

An authorised officer of the enforcement authority, may, in the case of emergency, move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit, vehicles left in a parking place.

14. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

### 15. Removal, Storage and Disposal of Vehicles from Parking Place

- (1) Where a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer has attached to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice pursuant to Article 9 of this Order he may thereafter remove or cause the vehicle to be removed from the parking place.
- (2) Where a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place (s)he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place.
- (3) Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 14 of this Order or paragraph (1) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as (s)he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as (s)he may think necessary to enable him/her to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- (4) When a person authorised by the enforcement authority removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place by virtue of this Article (s)he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- (5) Any vehicle removed from a parking place may be removed or disposed of in accordance with Sections 101 to 103 of the Act of 1984
- (6) The provisions of Section 99 and 101 to 103 of the Act of 1984, the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978 (as amended), the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 and the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986 (as amended) shall apply in relation to any vehicle if it appears to the Council to have been abandoned without lawful authority in the parking place.

### 16. Suspension of Parking Place

(1) At its discretion the enforcement authority may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof and may indicate by traffic sign or any other such means as appear to be appropriate that use of the parking place or part thereof is suspended.

- (2) When use of a parking place or any part thereof has been suspended no person shall, without the prior consent of the enforcement authority, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed or wait in that parking place or part thereof, the use of which has been suspended.
- (3) An authorised officer of the enforcement authority may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever (s)he considers such suspension reasonably necessary always provided that adequate prior notice has been received;
  - (a) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to or in the parking place;
  - (b) for the purpose of maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or any part thereof, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the parking place of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (4) Subject to the proviso contained in paragraph 7 of this Article any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of this Article shall thereupon:-
  - (a) place or cause to be placed in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of this Article in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
  - (b) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in the parking place or part thereof, as the case may be, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof a traffic sign placed in pursuance of Paragraph (4) of this Article.
- (5) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article if the use of a parking place or any part thereof is suspended during the charging hours for any of the purposes of paragraph (3) of this Article except sub paragraph (a) a penalty charge equivalent to a full days parking in that parking place shall be payable by the person or body requesting the suspension of use of the parking place for each parking bay suspended in respect of each day or part thereof during which use of the parking place or part thereof is suspended.
- (6) Subject to the proviso contained herein no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a parking place during such period as there is a cover or a notice or traffic sign within the parking place placed in pursuance of paragraphs (4) or (5) of this Article PROVIDED that nothing in this paragraph shall apply to:-
  - (i) fire brigade, ambulance or police in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(ii) any other vehicle if that vehicle is so left with the permission of the person who authorised suspension of use of the parking place or part thereof in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.

### 17. Exemption From Charges

- (1) No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be payable in respect of a vehicle waiting in a parking place if the vehicle is being used:-
  - (i) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (ii) for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the access road to and from the main carriageway; or
  - (iii) for the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (iv) for fire brigade, ambulance or police in pursuance of statutory duties or powers;
  - (v) by the local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (vi) by a universal service provider as defined in Section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125(1) of that Act;
  - (vii) when the driver of the vehicle:-
    - (A) is required by the law to stop;
    - (B) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside the control of the driver;
- (2) If a pay on foot ticket machine is out of order then a civil enforcement officer/authorised officer may place a notice nominating another pay on foot ticket machine in the locality at which payment may be made.
- (3) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions of this Article nothing in this Article shall be taken to exempt any vehicle left in any parking place from any other provisions of this Order.

### <u>PART III</u> <u>LIABILITY AND OTHER PROVISIONS</u>

### 18. Liability

The Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage to vehicles or other property left in any of the parking places to which this Order applies save for that arising from the negligence of the Council.

### 19. Validity

If a court, the Department for Transport, the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.

### 20. Driving within a parking place

Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of

- (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
- (ii) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place,

any person who drives or permits to be driven any vehicle

- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated, or
- (ii) in a direction other than so specified shall be liable to prosecution.

Any person who, without with the permission of an authorised officer of the enforcement authority, drives or permits to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place shall be liable to prosecution.

### 21 Wilful damage

Any person who with intent to defraud interferes with a pay on foot ticket machine or operates or attempts to operate it by the insertion of objects other than undamaged and unaltered coins of legal tender and of the appropriate denomination, shall be liable to prosecution.

### 22. Domestic purposes

Any person who uses any part of the parking place or any vehicle parked in a parking place

- (i) for sleeping or camping or cooking unless in a parking place as described in the First, Second and Third Schedules and undertaken only within the vehicle, or
- (ii) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to depart from the parking place, shall be liable to prosecution.

### 23. Behaviour

Any person who wilfully sounds any horn or any other similar instrument on a vehicle except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place shall be liable to prosecution.

- 24. Any person who in a parking place shouts or otherwise makes any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents or premises in the neighbourhood shall be liable to prosecution.
- 25. Any person who in a parking place uses any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned shall be liable to prosecution.

### 26. Other activities

Any person who in a parking place

- (i) erects or causes or permits to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council, or
- (ii) lights or causes to be lit any fire,
- (iii) causes wilful or deliberate damage to the fabric of the car park
- (iii) Cycles or skateboards in the car park shall be liable to prosecution.

### 27. Compliance with Signs

- (1) If any parking bay in a parking place is marked out as being reserved for the use of a vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge, no person shall cause any vehicle which is not displaying a valid disabled persons badge to park therein.
- (2) If any cones, signs, markers or any other such means as appear to be appropriate

are placed or erected in a parking place or any part thereof has been suspended, no person shall, except with the prior consent of the enforcement authority, cause any vehicle to park therein.

### 28. Waiting by Vehicles on Roadways

- (1) Save as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Article no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any roadway giving access to or egress from a parking place.
- (2) Nothing in Paragraph (1) of this Article shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait on any such roadway as is mentioned therein for as long as may be necessary if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his/her control or to such waiting as is necessary to prevent an accident.

### <u>PART IV</u> GENERAL

- 29. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment
- 30. The exercise by the enforcement authority of its powers under this Order shall not render it subject to any liability under any circumstances whatsoever for the negligence or default of its servants, agents or any persons in respect of loss of or damage to any vehicle or the fittings or contents of any vehicle, or other property left in any of the enforcement authority's parking places to which this Order applies.
- As provided by Section 35(A)(3)(c) of the Act of 1984 this Order incorporates into it the provisions of Sub Sections (4) and (6) of Section 47 of the Act of 1984.
- 32. The enforcement authority may institute proceedings in accordance with the provisions of Section 35A of the Act of 1984.
- 33.
