

**WALSALL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BUS LANES, BUS
GATES AND BUS ONLY STREETS) ORDER 2011
(AMENDMENT NO.1) FEBRUARY 2013**

The Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 & 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) hereinafter referred to as "The Act", and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 11 March, 2013, and may be cited as the "Walsall Metropolitan Borough, (Bus Lanes, Bus Gates and Bus Only Streets) Order, 2011 (Amendment No.1) February 2013".

Interpretation

2. (1) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

General

3. Under this order, Schedule 1 contained in the Walsall Metropolitan Borough (Bus Lanes, Bus Gates And Bus Only Streets) Order 2011 shall be substituted by Schedule 1 in this Order.

A34 Birmingham Road, Walsall	The area of the northbound carriageway of Birmingham Road from the Walsall/Sandwell borough boundary for a distance of 461 metres in a north-westerly direction, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority.	At Any Time.

High Street Bloxwich	The area of westbound carriageway of High Street which extends from a point 19 metres west of its junction with Pinfold, for a distance of 137 metres in a westerly direction bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority.	8am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6.30pm Monday to Friday
Pleck Road Walsall	The area of southbound offside carriageway of Pleck Road which extends from its junction with Wolverhampton Street to a point 40 metres north east of its junction with Bridgeman Street, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority. Pleck Road Walsall	The area of northbound carriageway of Pleck Road which extends from a point 58 metres north of the northern kerblines of Moat Road to its junction with Wolverhampton Street, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority. Somerford Place Willenhall	The area of westbound carriageway of Somerford Place which extends from a point 70 metres west of its junction with Summer Street westwards for a distance of 155 metres, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority.	8am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6.30pm Monday to Friday
Wolverhampton Road Walsall	The area of eastbound carriageway of Wolverhampton Road which extends from its junction with Pargeter Street eastwards for 205 metres, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority.	7am to 10am and 4pm to 7pm Monday to Friday
Wolverhampton Road Walsall	The area of eastbound carriageway of Wolverhampton Road which extends from a point 112 metres west of its junction with Hollyhedge Lane, eastwards for 100 metres, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority. Wolverhampton Road West Bentley	The area of eastbound carriageway of Wolverhampton Road West which extends from its junction with Queen Elizabeth Avenue 435 metres eastwards to its junction with Wolverhampton Road Service Road, bounded by kerblines and/or delineating road markings as prescribed for such a purpose in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions or otherwise authorised by the relevant national authority.
