The Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 & 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 1st February 2016, and may be cited as the "Walsall Metropolitan Borough (Bus Lanes, Bus Gates and Bus Only Streets) Order, 2015".

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In this Order: -
 - a. a reference to an Article or Schedule followed by a number is a reference to the Article of, or Schedule to, this Order so numbered;
 - b. "authorised person" means a person appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order;
 - c. "bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
 - d. "bus lane" has the same meaning as in Section 144 of the Transport Act 2000 and Part 2 of Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and includes the terms "bus gate" "contra-flow bus lane" and "bus only street";
 - e. "carriageway" has the same meaning as in Section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980;
 - f. "cause" includes permit, and causing shall be construed accordingly:
 - g. "taxi" means in England and Wales, a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847; or Section 6 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869; or under any similar enactment;
 - h. "motorcycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of "The Act";
 - i. "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
 - j. "vehicle" includes any part of the vehicle;
 - k. "relevant national authority" has the same meaning as in Section 144 of theTransport Act 2004;
 - (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of Driving

- Save as provided in Articles 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 no person shall cause a vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, motorcycle or licensed taxi to be in the bus lanes specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 during the hours of operation specified in column 3 of Schedule 1.
- 3a. Save as provided in Articles 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 no person shall cause a vehicle other than a bus or pedal cycle to be in the bus lanes specified in column 2 of Schedule 1a during the hours of operation specified in column 3 of Schedule 1a.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 no person shall cause a vehicle other than a bus or pedal cycle to be in the contra-flow bus lanes specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 during the hours of operation specified in column 3 of Schedule 2.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 no person shall cause a vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle or licensed taxi to be in the bus gates specified in column 2 of Schedule 3 during the hours of operation specified in column 3 of Schedule 3.
- Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 no person shall cause a vehicle other than a bus to be in the bus only street specified in column 2 of Schedule 4 during the hours of operation specified in column 3 of Schedule 4.

Exemptions

- 7. Nothing in Articles 3, 3a, 4, 5, and 6 of this Order shall apply to any person causing a vehicle to enter or proceed in the bus lanes, contra-flow bus lanes, bus gates and bus only streets referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary;
 - a. to enable the getting or giving of help in consequence of an accident or an emergency, or otherwise taking action for public safety;
 - to enable the vehicle to be used in an emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - d. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road.
- 8. Nothing in Article 3, 3a and 6 of this Order shall apply to any person causing a vehicle in the service of a universal service provider (as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000) to deliver or collect postal packets to premises or mail boxes adjacent to the bus lanes and bus only streets.

- Nothing in Article 3, 3a, 4, 5, and 6 of this Order shall apply to any person causing a
 vehicle to be in the bus lanes, contra-flow bus lanes, bus gates and bus only streets
 referred to therein upon the direction or with the permission of an authorised person
 or a Police Officer in uniform.
- 10. Nothing in Article 3, 3a and 6 of this Order will apply to a vehicle requiring access to or from off street loading or garage premises adjacent to the bus lane or accessible only from a bus only street.
- 11. When loading is permitted at the kerbside, nothing in Articles 3, 3a and 6 of this Order shall apply to any person causing a vehicle to be in the bus lanes and bus only streets referred to therein in order to load or unload the vehicle.
- 12. The Traffic Regulation Orders specified in Schedule 5 to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent indicated therein.
