THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 100) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2015

The Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- 3. The making of this Order by the Council is done so under the duty imposed by Section 122(1) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the Highway, insofar as practicable having regard to the matters in Section 122(2) of the said Act.
- 4. The Borough of Warrington (Various Roads) (School Keep Clear) Order 2008, is revoked in so far as it relates to the No Stopping on School Entrance Markings 8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday to Friday on Quebec Road (South Side).
- 5. The Borough of Warrington (Gorsey Lane, Manchester Road, Earl Street and Willis Street) (Disabled Person's Parking Places) Order 2006, is revoked in so far as it relates to the Disabled Persons Parking Place on Gorsey Lane.
- 6. The Order specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby varied or amended as detailed in the said Schedule.
- 7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 8. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July 2015 and may be cited as "The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 100) Consolidation Order 2015".

SCHEDULE

The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2008, is hereby further varied or amended as follows: -

(a) In the Second Schedule by the deletion of: -

NO LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

Winmarleigh Street (East Side)

From its junction with Sankey Street for a distance of 13.3 metres in a southerly direction.

(b) In the Sixth Schedule by the deletion of: -

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

From its junction with Warrington Road to a point 17.8 Church Lane, metres north west of the centerline of Paythorne Close. Culcheth (South West Side) Between its junction with Padgate Lane and a point 8.3 Gorsey Lane metres northwest of its junction with Oakwood Avenue. (North East Side) From its junction with Knutsford Road for a distance of Mayfield Road 10 metres in a northerly direction. From a point 93.4 metres north of its junction with Warrington Road, Newton Avenue for a distance of 54.6 metres in a Birchwood northerly direction. (East Side) From its junction with Sankey Street for a distance of Winmarleigh Street 13.3 metres in a southerly direction. (East Side)

(c) In the Fortieth Schedule by the deletion of: -

Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the north east side of the rear of London Road which is bounded on the north east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 23 metres south east of its junction with East Avenue, in a south easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the south east side of Mayfield Road which is bounded on the south east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 7.5 metres north of its junction with Knutsford Road, in a northerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the southern-most parking bay in the parking area to the rear of property number 10 Minerva Close which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Perpendicular to the kerb

All that part of the south east side of Orford Avenue which is bounded on the south east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 47 metres south west of its junction with Richardson Street, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the east side of Wellfield Street which is bounded on the east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 33 metres south of its junction with Percy Street, in a southerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the north west side of Wellington Street which is bounded on the north west side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 9 metres south west of its junction with Ellesmere Street, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb

(g) In the Fifty Third Schedule by the addition of: -

NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00AM TO 5:00PM, MONDAY TO FRIDAY

Quebec Road From a point 32.7 metres south west of its junction with (South Side) Gorsey Lane, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 31.56 metres.

(h) In the Sixty Sixth Schedule by the addition of: -

WAITING LIMITED TO 1 HOUR, NO RETURN WITHIN 1 HOUR

Warrington Road (South East Side)

 From a point 30 metres south west of its junction with Daten Avenue for a distance of 17 metres, in a south westerly direction.
 From a point 25 metres south west of its junction with Birchwood Park Avenue for a distance of 15 metres, in a south westerly direction.
