THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 119)(PART 1) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2016

The Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- 3. The making of this Order by the Council is done so under the duty imposed by Section 122(1) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the Highway, insofar as practicable having regard to the matters in Section 122(2) of the said Act.
- 4. The Borough of Warrington (Slater Street, Grosvenor Avenue, Derby Road, Cross Street and Laira Street) (Revocation and Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2009 is revoked in so far as it relates to the Disabled Persons Parking Place on Derby Road.
- 5. The Borough of Warrington (Padgate Lane, St Mary's Street, Oxford Street, Chester Road, Warrington Road and Earl Street) (Revocation and Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2007 is revoked in so far as it relates to the Disabled Persons Parking Place on Padgate Lane.
- 6. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 8) Consolidation Order 2009 is revoked in so far as it relates to the Disabled Persons Parking Place on Thynne Street.
- 7. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 16) Consolidation Order 2010 is revoked in so far as it relates to No Waiting Between The Hours of 8.00a.m. and 8.00p.m. Monday to Saturday on Sandy Lane (North West Side and South East Side).
- 8. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 32) Consolidation Order 2011, is revoked in so far as it relates to No Waiting At Any Time on Myddleton Lane (South East Side).
- 9. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 52) Consolidation Order 2012 is revoked in so far as it relates to the following:-
