# THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2014

The Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cheshire Constabulary in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 2014 and may be cited as The Borough of Warrington (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 1) Consolidation Order 2014.
- 2. Except where the context requires otherwise, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in the Order referred to in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 4. Unless the context otherwise requires words denoting the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words denoting the persons shall include either gender, bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- 6. The making of this Order by the council is done so under the duty imposed by Section 122(1) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the Highway, insofar as practicable having regard to the matters in Section 122(2) of the said Act.
- 7. The Order specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby varied or amended as detailed in the said Schedule.
- 8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

#### **SCHEDULE**

The Borough of Warrington (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civic Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2008, is hereby further varied or amended as follows:-

#### AMENDED SCHEDULES/ARTICLES

- (a) Article 7 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 7. The areas of land specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 to this Order may be used subject to the provisions of this Order, as places to leave vehicles, subject to the terms of use as detailed in the said Schedules.
- (b) Article 8 is amended by the deletion from the said article of the wording "Where by Notice at a Parking Place".
- (c) Article 13 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 13. A Parking Place is described as available on specified days, during specified hours or for a maximum period of stay as detailed in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 to this Order, where no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in that Parking Place on any day during such hours or for any period other or longer than those specified in the said Schedules.
- (d) Article 14 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 14. A Parking Place is described as having a period within which a vehicle may not return as detailed in Schedules 2 and 4 to this Order, where no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in that Parking Place on any day, during such periods as detailed in the said Schedules.
- (e) Article 21 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 21. The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall upon leaving the vehicle in the Parking Place pay the appropriate charge (if any) in accordance with the scale of current charges as detailed in Schedules 2, 3 and 4 to this Order.
- (f) Article 23 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 23. The charges referred to in Article 21 shall be payable in the manner as detailed in Schedules 2, 3 and 4 to this Order.

- (g) Article 31 is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - 31. Parking Permits are available from the Council at the appropriate fee, for a vehicle of a specific class and for specified parking places or car parks as detailed in Schedules 3, 4, 5 and 6 to this Order, subject to conditions determined by the Council.
- (h) Article 40 (iii) is deleted and replaced by the following: -
  - (iii) a vehicle left displaying, in a relevant position, a valid Parking Permit issued in respect of specified parking places or car parks as detailed in Schedules 3, 4, 5 and 6 to this Order.
- (i) The Schedule to the Order is revoked in its entirety and the following Schedules are introduced: -
