THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (NEWHOUSE CRESCENT, WATFORD) (DESIGNATED PARKING BAYS) ORDER 2017

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Function) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of their powers under Section 32 & 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Watford (Newhouse Crescent, Watford) (Designated parking bays) Order 2017" and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of October 2017.
2. Those lengths of Newhouse Crescent, Watford specified in the Schedule to this Order are designated (subject to the provisions of Article 3 to this Order) for use as parking bays at any time.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order which in Article 2 of this Order the length of Newhouse Crescent, Watford are described as designated for the use as a parking bays at any time, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in any parking bays unless it is wholly parked within the marked limits of the parking bay.
- 4(1). Nothing in article 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to-
 - a) A vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - b) Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in Uniform; or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Watford Borough Council.
 - c) A vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - d) A vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - e) A marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this article-

The expressions "universal service provider", "provisions of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

(2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are-

- a) Any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
- b) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;

- c) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - d) Constructing, improving maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
 - e) The laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
6. The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the act of 1984 or by any other enactment.
