

Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2012 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County under sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and Part 6 of The Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on 7th June 2021 and may be cited as The Borough of Watford (Eastbury Road, St Albans Road and The Harebreaks, Watford) (On-Street Pay and Display Parking Places) Minor Order 2021.
- 2 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. In this Order, the expression 'Enactment' means any enactment , whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
4. The Borough of Watford (Eastbury Road, Watford) (On-Street Pay and Display Parking Places) Order 2021 referred to as the '2021 Order' shall be amended in accordance with the Articles 5 to 8 of this Order.
5. Article 2 of the '2021 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the following:-  
"Pay by Phone" means a procedure by which an initial charge is paid using a phone.  
"Pay by Phone Facility" means a "Ticket Parking Meter" equipped for a phone facility whereby the person using a parking place may make and record the appropriate payment for that use;"
- 6 In Article 4.3 of the '2021 Order' paragraph (2) shall be substituted by the following:-  
"(2) Parking Places referred to in the Schedule to this Order may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in paragraph (1) above provided:  
(a) there is displayed thereon in the manner specified in Article 4.7 a valid parking ticket for no longer than a period specified thereon , or  
(b) payment has been made of an initial charge via pay by phone in parking places with pay by phone facilities,  
and the vehicle not be returned to the same parking place within a period of 1 hour , with the exception of those vehicles set out in Article 3.5.

- 7 Article 4.7 of the '2021 Order' shall be amended by the addition of a paragraph (3) "(3) In the case of pay by phone parking the provisions of this Article do not apply."
- 8 Article 4.9 of the '2021 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the text "or by payment using a pay by phone facility" at the end of paragraph (1) and by the addition of paragraph (5) "(5) Paragraph (2) shall not apply if payment has been made by pay by phone."
- 9 The Borough of Watford (St Albans Road and Various Side Roads) (Parking Places) Order 2006 (as amended) referred to as the '2006 Order' shall be amended in accordance with the Articles 10 to 18 of this Order.
- 10 Article 2 of the '2006 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the following:-  
"pay by phone" means a procedure by which a parking charge is paid using a phone.  
"pay by phone Facility" means a "ticket parking meter" equipped for a phone facility whereby the person using a parking place may make and record the appropriate payment for that use;"
- 11 Article 5 of the '2006 Order' shall be substituted by the following:-  
"5. Each parking place referred to in the Schedule 1, 2 or 4 to this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4A above provided:  
(a) there is displayed thereon in the manner specified in Article 6 a valid parking ticket for no longer than a period specified thereon , or  
(b) payment has been made of an initial charge via pay by phone in parking places with pay by phone facilities,
- 12 Article 6 of the '2006 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the following text:-  
"In the case that payment is made by pay by phone facilities the provisions of this Article do not apply."
- 13 Article 17 of the '2006 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the text "or for which payment of the parking charge has been made via pay by phone in parking places with pay by phone facilities".
- 14 Article 18 of the '2006 Order' shall be amended by the addition of paragraph (3) as follows:-  
" (3) The provisions of this Article shall not apply where a payment of the initial charge has been made by pay by phone in parking places with pay by phone facilities".
- 15 Article 19 paragraph (1) of the "2006 Order" shall be amended by the addition after the text" with the provisions of Article 6" of the text "or no payment has been made by pay by phone"
- 16 Article 19 of the "2006 Order" shall be amended by the addition of paragraph (2A) as follows:-  
"(2A) Subject to Article 20 , if at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place referred to in Schedule 1, 2 or 4 during the permitted hours the duration of stay of the vehicle exceeds the parking period for which a payment has been made by pay by phone it shall be presumed , unless the contrary is proved, that the parking charge has been duly paid in respect of that vehicle, and that the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge has already expired."

- 17 Article 19 paragraph (3) of the "2006 Order" shall be amended by the substitution of the text "paragraph (2)" by the text "paragraphs (2) and (2A)".
- 18 Article 22 of the "2006 Order" shall be amended by the addition of the text "or paid the parking charge by pay by phone" after the text "having displayed a ticket".
19. The Borough of Watford (St Albans Road, Watford) (On-Street Pay and Display Parking Place) Order 2017 referred to as the '2017 Order' shall be amended in accordance with the Articles 20 to 23 of this Order.
20. Article 2 of the '2017 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the following:-  
 "Pay by Phone" means a procedure by which a parking charge is paid using a phone.  
 "Pay by Phone Facility" means a "Ticket Parking Meter" equipped for a phone facility whereby the person using a parking place may make and record the appropriate payment for that use;"
21. In Article 5 of the '2017 Order' paragraph (2) shall be substituted by the following:-  
 "(2) Parking Places referred to in the Schedule to this Order may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in paragraph (1) above provided:  
 (a) there is displayed thereon in the manner specified in Article 15 a valid parking ticket for no longer than a period specified thereon , or  
 (b) payment has been made of an initial charge via pay by phone in parking places with pay by phone facilities,  
 and the vehicle not be returned to the same parking place within a period of 1 hour.
- 22 Article 15 of the '2017 Order' shall be amended by the addition of a paragraph (3) "(3) In the case of pay by phone parking the provisions of this Article do not apply."
23. Article 17 of the '2017 Order' shall be amended by the addition of the text "or by payment using a pay by phone facility" at the end of paragraph (1) and by the addition of paragraph (5) "(5) Paragraph (2) shall not apply if payment has been made by pay by phone."
