## The Borough of Watford Hackney Carriage Stand (St John's Road and Woodford Road) Appointment 2020

- 1. The Watford Borough Council in exercise of powers conferred on it under Sections 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 hereby makes the following appointment of hackney carriage stands in the Borough.
- 2. The appointment shall come into operation on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2020 and may be cited as The Borough of Watford Hackney Carriage Stand (St John's Road and Woodford Road) Appointment 2020.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a hackney carriage to wait on the stand for hackney carriages as set out in the Schedule below during the period for which that stand has been appointed.
- 4. The Borough of Watford Hackney Carriage Stand Appointment 2017 shall have effect as though the items in the table therein relating to the 'Road' Shady Lane & Clarendon Road were hereby omitted.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Article 3 of this Appointment applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as the "the restricted area") in relation to-
  - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes;
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Watford Borough Council;
  - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
  - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area:
  - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected.

## In this Article-

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are-
  - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
  - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (c) the maintenance of the Public Highway;

- (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture;
- the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of the telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.

Woodford Road	South-west	From a point 20.2 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of St. John's Road north-westwards for a distance of 104 metres.	24 hours
