The Borough of Watford (Prince Street) (No Waiting at Any time and Parking Places for Residents with Permits) Order 2002

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that County under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order;-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Watford (Prince Street) (No Waiting at Any time and Parking Places for Residents with Permits) Order 2002 and shall come into operation on 31st October 2002.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time on lengths of road in Watford specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order, Parking Places for Residents with Permits as defined in The Borough of Watford(Central Area Controlled Parking Zone B)Order 1982 Part 2 paragraphs 4 to 23, are to be provided as in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- Revoke The Borough of Watford(Central Area Controlled Parking Zone
 B)Order,1982 Schedule 2 Prince Street South Side and Schedule 3 Prince Street South Side.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply to any emergency service vehicle, which is being used for an emergency purpose where the restriction would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle in fulfilling that emergency purpose, and is making use of visual and/or audible warning devices.
- 6. Nothing in Article 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;

- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (v) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to

used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory

powers or duties;

- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any 7. restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Schedule 1

Lengths of Prince Street in Watford-proposed no waiting at any time, both sides

From a point 20m west of its junction with Queens Road for a distance of 20m in a westerly direction.

Schedule 2

Lengths of Prince Street in Watford-proposed Parking Places for Residents with Permits

From a point 10m west of its junction with Queens Road for a distance of 10m in a westerly direction.
