THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (BRADSHAW ROAD AREA)  
(LIMITED WAITING) ORDER 1988

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (3) and 4(2) and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on *8<sup>th</sup> August*, 1988 and may be cited as The Borough of Watford (Bradshaw Road Area) (Limited Waiting) Order 1988.
2. (1) In this Order -
  - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons' (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982;
  - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) - England and Wales) Regulations 1986;
  - "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631 : 1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.
- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -
  - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
  - (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in any of the lengths of road or on the side of the turning head referred to in the Schedule specified in this Order -
- (a) for a longer period than one hour; or
  - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same length or side of road.
4. (1) Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road or on the side of the turning head referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths or side of road;
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths or side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (e) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road or on the side of the turning head referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.

(3) Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait in any of the lengths of road or on the side of the turning head referred to in that Article.

5. The Schedule to the Borough of Watford (North Watford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984, in so far as it refers to the following streets, is hereby amended to read as follows -

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Hatfield Road - Both sides - from a point 13 metres from its junction with St. Albans Road for a distance of 31 metres in an easterly direction, and including the whole of the turning head.

Bruce Grove - Both sides - from a point 17 metres from its junction with St. Albans Road for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction, and including the whole of the turning head.

Cromer Road - (a) Both sides

From a point 12 metres from its junction with St. Albans Road for a distance of 32 metres in an easterly direction.

(b) Turning head

East side - the whole.

West side - from a point 12 metres from the northern end to a point 6 metres from its junction with the north-east side of Cromer Road.

Bradshaw Road (West Side) - (1) From its junction with Cromer Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

(2) From its junction with Yarmouth Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction and for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

(3) From its junction with Bruce Grove for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction and for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

(4) From its junction with Salisbury Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction and for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

(5) From its junction with Hatfield Road for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

6. The Schedule to the Borough of Watford (North Watford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984, as refers to Bradshaw Road (east side), is hereby revoked.
7. The Schedule to the Borough of Watford (Bradshaw Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984, as refers to Bradshaw Road (west side), is hereby revoked.
8. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail.
9. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

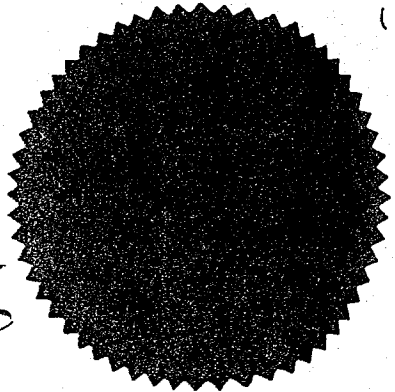
Lengths of road and side of turning head in the Borough of Watford

WAITING LIMITED TO ONE HOUR IN ANY TWO - 8 a.m. - 6.30 p.m.

- (i) Hatfield Road - both sides: from a point 7 metres from its junction with St Albans Road for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction and including the western end.
- (ii) Bruce Grove - both sides: from a point 11 metres from its junction with St Albans Road for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction and including the western end.
- (iii) Cromer Road - both sides: from a point 6 metres from its junction with St Albans Road for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction and including the western end.
- (iv) Cromer Road - turning head: west side from the northern end for a distance of 12 metres in a southerly direction.

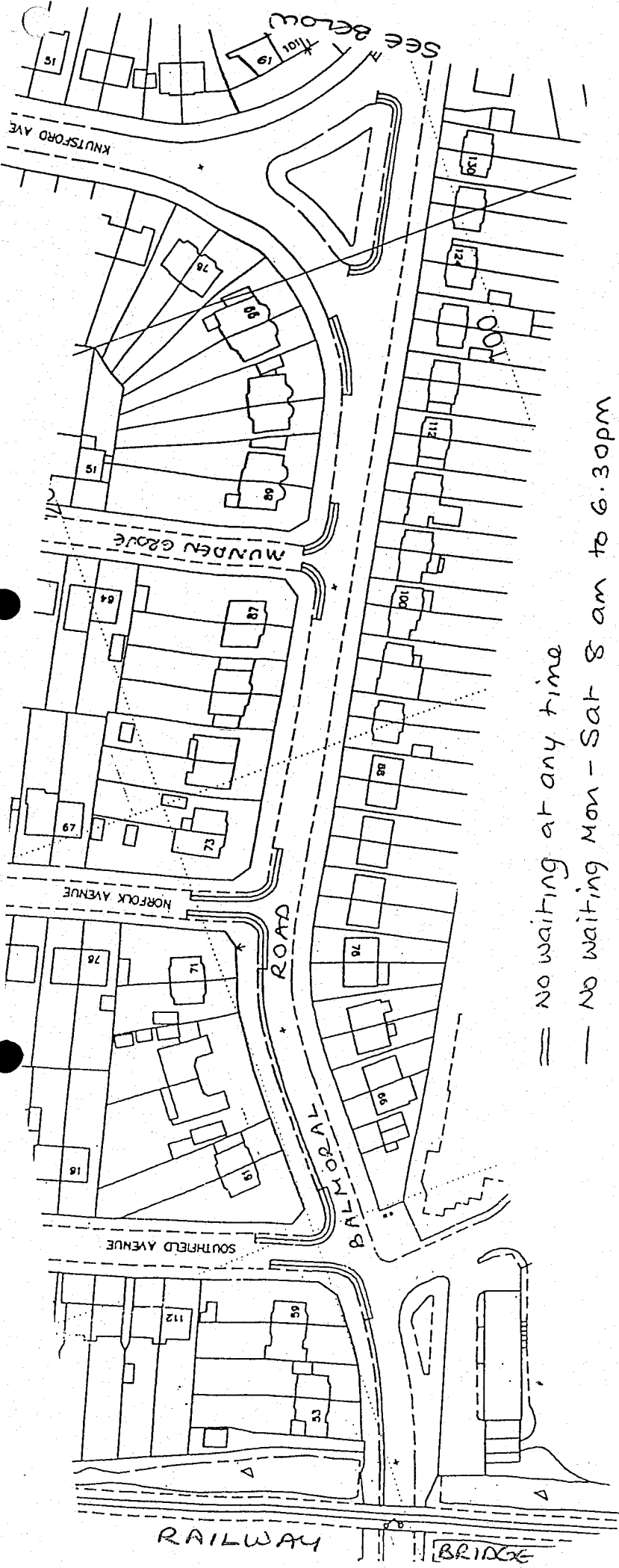
