## WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

### THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING & RESTRICTION OF WAITING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) ORDER 2000

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that County under Sections 1, 2(1) to (2), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order; -

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Watford (Prohibition of stopping & restriction of waiting outside schools) Order 1999 and shall come into operation on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2000.

2. (1) In this Order -

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 124mm square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

and

"relevant position" means

(i) a vehicle displays a disabled person's badge issued before 2 March 1992 in the relevant position if -

(a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle, or

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

(ii) a vehicle displays a disabled person's badge issued on or after 2 March 1992 in the relevant position if -

- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle, or
  - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle, and
- (iii) a vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if –
  - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle, or
  - (b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm on Monday to Friday inclusive on the sides of road or the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (4) Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 7 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm on Monday-Friday inclusive on the sides of road or the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- (5) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road or lengths of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable –
  - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or lengths of road;

- (iv) adjacent to the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any Telecommunication apparatus as defined in Paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (d) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road or lengths of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle
  - (b) loading or unloading
7. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of road or in the lengths of road referred to in that Article, for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road or in the same length of road on the same day), provided that such period lies entirely within the period during which loading is permitted in that location.
8. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
9. Article 4 to The Borough of Watford (north Watford) (Prohibition and restriction of waiting) Order 1992 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "Save as provided in Article 6 of the Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 3.00pm on any day other than Saturday or Sunday on the side of the road referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order"



- 9 Cedar Wood Drive  
(Stanborough Secondary School)  
a) south side (i) for a distance of 48 metres centred on the centre of the access to Stanborough Secondary School
- 10 Coates Way (Coates Way JMI School)  
a) east side (i) from a point 6 metres south-west of its junction with Coates Dell in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres  
(ii) from a point 52 metres north of its junction with Coates Dell in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres  
(iii) from a point 79 metres north of its junction with Coates Dell in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres
- 11 Croxley View  
(St Anthony's RC School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 234 north west of its northern junction with Tolpits Lane in a north westerly direction for a distance of 32 metres
- 12 Croxley View (Westfield Secondary School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 113 metres north west of its northern junction with Tolpits Lane in a north westerly direction for a distance of 37 metres  
(ii) from a point 45 metres north west of its northern junction with Tolpits Lane in a north westerly direction for a distance of 37 metres
- 13 Elfrida Road (Field Junior School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 41 metres south east of its junction with Neal Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres
- 14 Fourth Avenue  
(Garston Infants & Lea Farm Junior School)  
a) south west end (i) from a point 21 metres south west of its Junction with First Avenue for a distance of 40 metres including the whole of the cul-de-sac end
- 15 Gammons Lane  
(Beechfield Junior School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 74 metres south east of its junction with Gammons Farm Close in a south easterly direction for a distance of 96 metres

- 16 Gammons Lane (Orchard JMI School)  
a) north side (i) from a point 55 metres south east of its junction with Gammons Farm Close in a south easterly direction for a distance of 96 metres
- 17 Haines Way (Leavesden Green JMI School)  
a) south side (i) from a point 61 metres east of its junction with High Road, Leavesden in an easterly direction for a distance of 64 metres
- 18 Harvest End (Meriden JMI School)  
a) east side (i) from a point 16 metres south of its junction with York Way in a south westerly direction for a distance of 43 metres  
b) south side (i) from a point 60 metres south and west of its junction with York Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 64 metres
- 19 Harwoods Road (Chater Infants School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 11 metres south east of its junction with Kings Avenue in a south easterly direction for a distance of 24 metres
- 20 High View (Holywell JMI School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point opposite a point 37 metres north west of its junction with Combe Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 45 metres
- 21 Horseshoe Lane (Francis Combe School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point opposite its junction with Newhouse Crescent (south) in a north westerly direction for a distance of 36 metres
- 22 Knutsford Avenue (Knutsford JMI School)  
a) south east side (i) from a point 98 metres north east of its junction with Balmoral Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 29 metres
- 23 <sup>Lady's</sup> Langley's Close (Watford Girls Grammar School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 25 metres south west of its junction with Exchange Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 84 metres

- 24 Langley Road (Nascot Wood JMI School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 35 metres south east of its junction with Nascot Wood Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres
- 25 Neal Street (Field Infants School)  
a) north east end (i) from a point 17 metres north east of the junction with Roberts Road in a north easterly, north westerly and south direction for a distance of 25 metres
- 26 Newhouse Crescent (Alban Wood Junior School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 16 metres south east of its junction with the brow in a south easterly direction for a distance of 54 metres
- 27 North Approach (Kingsway Infant School)  
a) south east side (i) for a distance of 30 metres centred on the centre of the access to Kingsway Infants School
- 28 Northfield Gardens (Parkgate Infants School)  
a) north west & north east sides (i) from a point 135 metres north east of its junction with Bushey Mill Lane in a north easterly and then south easterly direction for a distance of 28 metres
- 29 Oxhey Road (Bromet JMI School)  
a) north east side (i) from a point 105 metres south east of its junction with Kingsfield Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 32 metres
- 30 Parkgate Road (Parkgate JM School)  
a) south east side (i) from a point 124 metres south west of its junction with Bushey Mill Lane in a south easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres
- 31 Ross Crescent (Kingsway Infants School)  
a) north side (i) From a point 10 metres north west of its eastern junction with Harris Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 metres
- 32 Shepherds Road (Watford Boys Grammar School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 93 metres north west of its junction with Rickmansworth Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 31 metres

- 33 Southsea Avenue (Chater  
Infants School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 73 metres south east of  
its junction with Durban Road West in  
a south easterly direction for a  
distance of 25 metres
- 34 The Brow (Alban Wood  
Infants School)  
a) north side (i) from a point 92 metres west of its  
junction with Louvain Way in a  
westerly direction for a distance of 38  
metres
- 35 Tolpits Lane (Holywell JMI  
School)  
a) east side (i) from a point opposite a point 14  
metres south west of its southern  
junction with Croxley View in a south  
westerly direction for a distance of 40  
metres
- 36 Watford Field Road (field JM  
School)  
a) south west side (i) from a point 10 metres north west of  
its junction with Lammas Road in a  
north westerly direction for a distance  
of 49 metres


