THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (COURTLANDS DRIVE AND
GOODWOOD PARADE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1970

The Council of the Borough of Watford in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on that side of length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order:-

(a) for a longer period than one hour; or

(b) if a period of less than three hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side of length of road.

3. Nothing in Article 1 or in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article, as the case may be, for so long as may be necessary:-

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

(b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;

(c) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;

(d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of road or the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said side of road or the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;

(e) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations

5. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

6. This Order shall come into operation on the *twenty first* day of *March* 1970 and may be cited as the Borough of Watford (Courtlands Drive and Goodwood Parade) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970.

SCHEDULE 1

Lengths and sides of lengths of road in the Borough of Watford

- (i) Chilcot Road both sides, for a distance of 50 yards south-east of its junction with Courtlands Drive.
- (ii) Courtlands Drive (a) the east side, from its junction with Gammons Lane to a point 60 yards north of its junction with Chilcot Road;
- (b) the west side, from a point 100 yards south of its junction with Goodwood Avenue to a point 3 yards north of that junction.
- (iii) Gammons Lane the north side, from its junction with Courtlands Drive in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 40 yards.
- (iv) Goodwood Avenue both sides, from its junction with Courtlands Drive for a distance of 80 yards in a north-westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

Side of length of road in the Borough of Watford

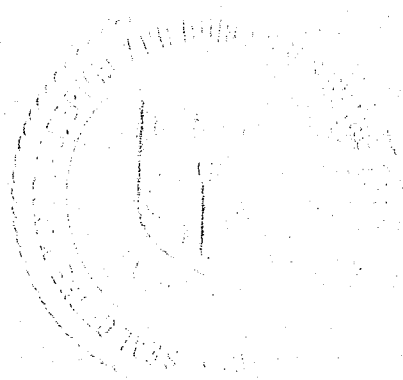
Courtlands Drive
