TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Order No. 712

The Borough of Watford (St Albans Road and Various Side Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2006

Made on: 23 March 2006
Coming into force on: 24 March 2006

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Watford (St Albans Road and Various Side Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 24 March 2006.

2. (1) In this Order:

"Council" means Watford Borough Council;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering" an "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise the restrictions and prohibitions of this Order;

"provision of a universal postal service", "universal service provider" and "postal packet" have the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000 (b);


"Disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" and "parking disc" have the same meaning as in regulation 3 (1) of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 (c), and "relevant position" has the same meaning as in regulation 4 of those regulations;

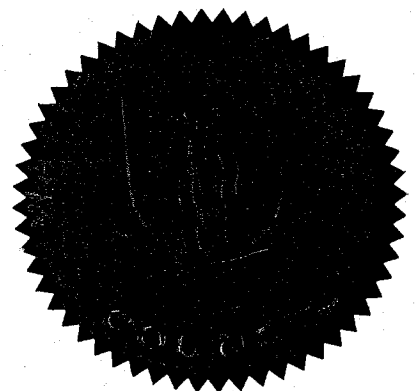
3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, No person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or an officer authorised by Watford Borough Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or wait for the purposes of loading and unloading goods to or from any vehicle in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 or 2 of this Order during the hours prescribed in those schedules.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, No person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or an officer authorised by Watford Borough Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 of this Order during the hours prescribed in that schedule.
5. (1) Nothing in Articles 1, 2 or 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
 - (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely;
 - (i) building industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to any traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the telecommunication Act 1984;
 - (v) to a vehicle being used for fire an rescue service, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000.
- (2) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle in the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order.
6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait in the lengths of street referred to in the said Article for a period of 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of street).
7. The Interpretation Act 1978 (1978 c.30) applies to this order as if it were an enactment

8. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption from the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
9. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order any restriction in the following Orders which refers to any of the lengths of road set out to in the schedules to this Order are hereby revoked:
- (i) The Hertfordshire (St Albans Road and Various Roads, Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1999 (Order No. 5630).
 - (ii) The Hertfordshire (St Albans Road and Various Roads, Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No.3) Order 1999 (Order No. 5635).
 - (iii) The Hertfordshire (A412-St Albans Road and Station Road, Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No.2) Order 1999 (Order No. 5634).
 - (iv) The Hertfordshire (Station Road and A412 St Albans Road, Watford) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions) (No.2) Order 1999 (Order No. 5631).
 - (v) The Borough of Watford (Bradshaw Road Area) (Limited Waiting) Order 1988.

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SCHEDULE 1

No waiting, Loading or Unloading at any time in relation to the lengths of road referred to the following schedule.

Street	Length of Road
St. Albans Road West side	(1) from the northern kerb-line of Lowestoft Road northwards for a distance of 43 metres.
	(2) from a point 58 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Regent Street northwards to a point 14 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Cecil Street.
	(3) from the southern kerb-line of Judge Street southwards for a distance of 17 metres
St. Albans Road East Side	(4) from a point 63 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Balmoral Road southwards for a distance of 24 metres.
	(5) from a point 27 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Yarmouth Road southwards to a point 11 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Yarmouth Road.
	(6) from a point 12 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Bruce Grove northwards for a distance of 8 metres.
	(7) from a point 5 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Salisbury Road southwards to a point 19 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Salisbury Road
	(8) from a point 90 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Brixton Road southwards to a point 47 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Brixton Road.

SCHEDULE 2

No Waiting, Loading or Unloading between 7.00am and 10.00 am and between 4.00pm and 7.00pm in relation to the lengths of road referred to the following schedule

Street	Length of Road
A412 St Albans Road East side	(1) from a point 3 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Windsor Road southwards to a point 63 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Balmoral Road.

A412 St Albans Road
West side

- (2) from a point 23 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Balmoral Road southwards for a distance of 90 metres.
- (3) from a point 37 metres south of the the southern kerb-line of Leavesden Road northwards to the southern kerb-line of Lowestoft Road.

No Waiting at any time, except for loading and unloading in relation to the lengths of road referred to the following schedule.

Street	Length of Street
Bruce Grove Both sides	(1) from a point 17 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St. Albans Road for a distance of 26 metres in an easterly direction, and including the whole of the turning head.
Cecil Street Northern side	(2) from the western kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 32 metres in an westerly direction.
Cecil Street Southern Side	(3) from the western kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 12 metres in an westerly direction. (4) from a point 18.6 metres from the western kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 18 metres in an westerly direction.
Cromer Road Northern side	(5) from a point 10 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St-Albans-Road for a distance of 7 metres in an easterly direction. (6) from a point 23 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.
Cromer Road Southern Side	(7) from a point 9 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.
Cromer Road	(8) Turning Head - east side, the whole length
Hatfield Road Northern side	(9) from a point 12 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 7 metres in an easterly direction. (10) from a point 31 metres from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 11 metres in an easterly direction, and including the whole of the turning head.

East side | (22) from a point 23 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Balmoral Road southwards for a distance of 90 metres. |

West side | (23) from the southern kerb-line of Gammons Lane to the northern kerb-line of Judge Street. |

Northern side | (24) from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 38 metres in an easterly direction. |

Southern Side | (25) from the eastern kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 40 metres in an easterly direction. |
| Victoria Road
Northern side | (26) from a point 12 metres from the western kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 28 metres in an westerly direction. |
| Victoria Road
Southern Side | (27) from a point 12 metres from the western kerb-line of St Albans Road for a distance of 32 metres in an westerly direction. |
