THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (VARIOUS STREETS, WATFORD) (RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1, 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Watford (Various Streets, Watford) (Restriction and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2008 and shall come into operation on the 25th August 2008.
- 2. (1) In this Order -

"designated officer" has the same meaning as in Article 2 of the Borough of Watford (Watford Central Area and West Watford) (Controlled Parking Zones) (Consolidation) Order 2006;

"disabled person's badge" and "parking disc" have the same meanings as in Regulation 3(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"relevant position" has the same meanings as in Regulation 4(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

(2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

- 3. Save as provided in Article 10 or 11 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order, at any time.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 10 or 11 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to in:

- (a) Schedule 2 to this Order, between the hours of 8 am to 6 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive; or
- (b) Schedule 3 to this Order, between the hours of 9 am to 12 noon on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (c) Schedule 4 to this Order, between the hours of 1 pm to 4 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 10 or 11 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to in Schedule 5 to this Order, between the hours of 7 am to 7 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 10 or 11 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to in Schedule 6 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than two hours; or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle in that same length of road.
- 7. Save as provided in Article 10 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purposes of loading or unloading from the vehicle on any length of road referred to in Schedule 7 to this Order at any time.
- 8. Save as provided in Article 10 and 11 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a designated officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a disabled person's vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge, to wait on any length of road referred to in Schedule 9 to this Order at any time.
- 9. Nothing in Article 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –

- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway;
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communication network within the meaning of the Communications Act 2003;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purpose.
- 10. Nothing in Article 3, 4, 5, 6 or 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable loading or unloading.
- 11. Nothing in Article 3, 4, 5, or 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length of road on the same day), provided that such period lies entirely within the period during which loading is permitted in that location.
- 12. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 13. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:
 - (a) The Borough of Watford (Leavesden Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1966 shall have effect as though the item numbered 7(a) in the Schedule to that Order were hereby revoked;

- (b) The Borough of Watford (North Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972 shall have effect as though the item numbered 11 in Schedule 1 and item numbered 16(a) in Schedule 2 to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (c) The Borough of Watford (Haines Way/High Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979 shall have effect as though the item relating to Haines Way in the Schedule to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (d) The Borough of Watford (Watford Football Ground Area) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988 shall have effect as though the items numbered 12 and 13 in the Schedule to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (e) The Borough of Watford (Park, Nascot & Leggatts Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1998 shall have effect as though the item numbered 1 in Schedule 1 to that Order and the items numbered 12 and 14 in Schedule 2 to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (f) The Borough of Watford (West Watford Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1998 shall have effect as though the item numbered 1 in Schedule 3 to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (g) The Borough of Watford (Oxhey and Bushey Arches Area) (Prohibition and restriction of waiting, loading and unloading) Order 1998 shall have effect as though the item numbered 13 in Schedule 1 to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (h) The Hertfordshire (Sheepcot Lane and adjacent roads, Watford) (Prohibition of Waiting – Except for Loading and Unloading) Order 2002 shall have effect as though the item numbered 1, 18, 19 and 20 in the Schedule to that Order were hereby revoked;
- (i) The Hertfordshire (St. Albans Road, Sheepcot Lane and Rochester Drive, Garston) (Resriction of Waiting) Order 2004 shall have effect as though the items relating to Sheepcot Lane (south side) and (north side) in the Schedule to that Order were hereby revoked;

- (k) The Borough of Watford (St. Albans Road and Various Side Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2006(a) shall have effect as though the length of street (2) of the item relating to A412 St. Albans Road, East side in Schedule 2 to that Order were hereby revoked; and
- (I) The Borough of Watford (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2006(b) shall have effect as though in Article 13 to that Order, the paragraph consisting of the following words were hereby omitted:

"In Schedule 1, item 8 headed "First Avenue b) south west side" (ii) from the centre line of the entrance to Beken Court for a distance of 12 metres in both a north westerly and south easterly direction.".
