WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (TERRACE GARDENS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1977

The Watford Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Borough of Watford (Terrace Gardens) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 is hereby revoked.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined by Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the sides of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1378;
 - (e) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the sides of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road).

In this Article -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS.4631: 1970), coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

"relevant position" means -

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.
- 5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or by or under any other enactment.
- 6. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Order revoked by Article 1 of this Order were an Act of Parliament thereby repealed.
- 7. This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd day of August, 1977 and may be cited as the Borough of Watford (Terrace Gardens) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1977.

SCHEDULE

Sides of Road in the Borough of Watford

- Terrace Gardens (a) the north and south sides from the junction with St. Albans Road for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction.
 - (b) the whole of the western end.
