THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (REEDS CRESCENT) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1998

The Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that County under Sections 1, 2(1) to (2), 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (REEDS CRESCENT) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1998 and shall come into operation on the 7th August 1998
- 2. (1) In this Order -

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act.

and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2A of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England and Wales) Regulations 1986.

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the west, north, and east side respectively of Reeds Crescent from a point 45 metres north of its western junction with Orphanage Road in a northerly, easterly and southerly direction to a point 15 metres north of its eastern junction with Orphanage Road between the hours of 1.00pm and 2.00pm on Monday Friday inclusive.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable -
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle
 - (b) loading or unloading

- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or lengths of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides of road or lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- 5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on any of the sides of road referred to in that Article.

6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
