THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (TOWN CENTRE CAR PARKS, HATFIELD) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT) (No.2) ORDER 2014

The Council of The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act of 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council ("the County Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 32, 33, 34, 35, 44, 45, 46, 47, 49, and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986) and Section 43 and Schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") and the provisions of Part 6 of The Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1st June 2015 and may be cited as "The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Town Centre Car Parks, Hatfield) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2014" hereinafter referred to as "this Order" and shall amend The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Town Centre Car Parks, Hatfield) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 referred to as "the Order of 2012"
- The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield, Town Centre, Hatfield Off-Street Car Parking Place Plans ("the Off-Street Plans") identified as HTC 02/04 rev 1 is incorporated into this Order.
- The Order of 2012 shall have the effect as though the following Off-Street plans identified as HTC 02/01 and HTC 02/03 shall be removed and substituted by the following Off-Street Plans HTC 02/01 rev 1 and HTC 02/03 rev 1 of this Order.
- 4. The Order of 2012 shall have the effect as though the following two sub articles shall be incorporated into The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Town Centre Car Parks, Hatfield) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 as Article 7(4) (a) and 7(4) (b).
 - a. Save as provided in Article 16 no person shall, except with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the restricted hours in any goods vehicle loading area shown on the Off-Street Plan HTC 02/04 Rev.1 unless it is a goods vehicle and is being used for the loading and unloading of goods.
 - b. Where there is specified on the Off-Street Plans a period of restricted hours for which loading or unloading is permitted, no person shall, except with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, cause or permit any goods vehicle to wait on any goods vehicle loading area for a period longer than is necessary to allow the operation of loading and unloading to be completed.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (TOWN CENTRE CAR PARKS, HATFIELD) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT) (No.2) ORDER 2014

The Welwyn Hatfield Council are proposing to amend a number of restrictions in The Common car park in Hatfield Town Centre to regulate and manage the parking and facilitate a larger turnover of vehicles. The changes are being proposed as a result of extensive consultation with businesses in the area. Requests were made to introduce a goods vehicle only loading bay and to increase the size of the parking bays to better facilitate shoppers. A review and monitoring of parking within this car park has been undertaken by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council.

The proposed amendments are as follows; Increase the number of disabled bays from 8 to 10.

Reduce the number of 3 hour restriction bays limited to 3 hours with no return within 3 hours 9.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday from 132 to 110

Introduce a loading bay

All the above restrictions have been subject to consultation with businesses in the area, with the Police, Hertfordshire County Council and local and County Councillors representing the area.
