WELWYN HATFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, WELWYN GARDEN CITY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2018

The Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council ("the County Council") under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2012 in exercise of the powers conferred under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Various Roads, Welwyn Garden City) (Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 2018" and shall come into effect on Monday 14th May 2018
- Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of road in Welwyn Garden City as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday in those lengths of road as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. (1) Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to-
 - (a) A vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council.
 - (c) A vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - (d) A vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - (e) A marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

- 4. (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are
 - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or

- (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 2 or 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary –
 - (a) To enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
 - (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 2 or 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1 of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

- 7. (1) Those lengths of "No waiting at any time" restrictions as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order and shall be removed from The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Various Roads, Welwyn Garden City) (Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 2016
 - (2) Those lengths of "No waiting 8:15am to 9:15am and 2:45pm to 3:45pm Monday to Friday during school term time" restrictions as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order and shall be removed from The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Various Roads, Welwyn Garden City) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2016
- 8. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 9. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.





STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

(RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2018

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, WELWYN GARDEN CITY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2016 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2018

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce "no waiting at any time" (Double Yellow Lines) and "No waiting Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm" (Single Yellow Lines) in Various Roads, Welwyn Garden City

The proposals are intended to prevent obstructions caused by vehicles parking too close to junctions, driveways and pedestrian dropped kerbs and to increase safety within the road.

The proposed restrictions are as follows;

No waiting at any time

In parts of Crookhams, Lumbards and Ingles.

No waiting 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday

• In parts of Crookhams.

Parking restrictions were introduced in parts of Crookhams and Lumbards in August 2016. The residents in the above roads were further consulted in August 2017. Residents expressed concerns about school related parking, which was also causing an obstruction to the public bus service route. It has also been identified pedestrian access to local shops are being impeded in Ingles.

Included in these proposed orders is a revocation of restrictions where road layout has been altered in parts of the road in Ingles and Warren Dale, and to correct a typing error in the previous order.

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic including pedestrians.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, and local residents have also been consulted.
