THE HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) GENERAL ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2008

Horsham District Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act of 1984'), Sections 43 and 63 to 79 inclusive of and Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of West Sussex County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order is supplemental to the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 ('the Original Order'), the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No.1) Order 2006 ('the First Amendment Order') and the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No. 2) Order 2006 ('the Second Amendment Order').
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th March 2008 and may be cited as the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No. 3) Order 2008.
- 3. The Original Order shall have effect and shall be read as if the Schedule hereto incorporating Categories A to U inclusive were substituted for the Schedule to the Original Order.
- 4. The following shall be substituted for Article 2 of the Original Order:

INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS

- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order, any reference in this Order to 'the Schedule' is a reference to the Schedule to this Order.
 - (2) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them 'Annual Fee' in relation to Parking Permits means the sum determined by the Council from time to time.

'Bus' means a vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers and as defined in Section 19 of the Transport Act 1985

'Car Park Attendant' means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any Parking Place and to enforce the provisions of this Order.

'Charging hours' means the period specified in column 5 of the Schedule during which the Parking Place is regulated and where applicable during which a charge is specified in Articles 8, 9 and 14 the amount of such a charge being specified in column 7 of the Schedule.

'Disabled Person's Badge' has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

'Disabled Person's Vehicle' has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

'Driver' in relation to a vehicle left in a parking space means the person in control of the vehicle at the time it was left in a Parking Place.

'Maximum Waiting Period' in relation to a vehicle displaying a Parking Permit means the period ending 24 hours after the arrival of that vehicle in a Parking Place.

'Owner', in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

'Parking Device' means either a card, disc, token, meter, permit, stamp or other similar device, whether used in a vehicle or not, of such type or design as may be approved by the Secretary of State either generally or specially, which, being used either by itself, or in conjunction with any such apparatus as referred to in Section 35(3A) and 35(3B) of the Act of 1984;

'Parking Disc' means an approved device obtained from the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a vehicle arrived at a Parking Place;

'Parking Disc Fee' means the sum determined by the Council from time to time:

'Parking Disc Hours' means in relation to Parking Places listed in Categories G and H of the Schedule the hours of 0800 or 0900 to 1800 on Mondays to Fridays or Saturdays inclusive (excluding Bank and Public Holidays);

'Parking Disc Parking Places' means the following parking places, or parts thereof, in categories G and H of the Schedule hereto where parking by the holders of a Parking Disc is allowed, namely:

North Street Storrington, Lower Street Pulborough, Newmans Gardens Steyning, Steyning Leisure Centre, the Recreation Ground Storrington, Monastery Lane Storrington, Swan Corner Pulborough, and Mill Lane Storrington.

'Parking Place' unless otherwise specified is a reference to all and any areas of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order;

'Parking Permit' means an approved Permit purchased from and issued by the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council showing the name of the business and the period in respect of which it is issued or where applicable showing that the permit holder is an employee of the Council or is an authorised visitor to the Council's Offices or showing such other information as the Council may determine;

'Parking Permit Parking Places' means the following parking places, or parts thereof, in categories G, H, N, P and R of the Schedule hereto where parking by the holders of a Parking Permit is allowed, namely:

North Street Storrington, Lower Street Pulborough, Mill Lane Storrington, British Telecom Exchange Horsham, Lintot Square Southwater (Fairbank Road and Station Road South), Park House Car Park North Street Horsham, the Access Road between Park North and the Capitol Horsham, and Dukes Square Horsham;

'Parking Voucher' means an approved device obtained from the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council having a value of £0.50 (or such other value as the Council may from time to time determine) for exhibiting in the Voucher Parking Parking Places;

'Penalty Charge' means the charge set under the provisions of Section 66 of the Act of 1991 which is to be paid to the Council following the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice; 'Penalty Charge Notice' means a notice issued or served by a Car Park Attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the Act of 1991.

'Voucher Parking Hours' means in relation to the Voucher Parking Parking Places the hours of 0800 or 0900 to 1800 on Mondays to Fridays or Saturdays inclusive (excluding Bank and Public Holidays);

'Voucher Parking Parking Places' means the following parking places, or parts thereof, in categories G and H of the Schedule hereto where parking by the purchasers of a Parking Voucher is allowed, namely:

North Street Storrington, Recreation Ground Storrington, Monastery Lane Storrington, and Mill Lane Storrington.

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment and the term enactment shall include any subordinate legislation and regulations.

SEASON TICKETS

- 5. The following shall be substituted for Article 9 of the Original Order:
- 9. (1) This Article applies only to Categories A, B, C (Piries Place Car Park Horsham only), F and Q of the Schedule.
 - (2) As an alternative to the method of payment referred to in Article 8 paragraph (3) a driver may purchase in advance a season ticket as detailed in column 7 of the Schedule allowing him to use the parking places.
 - (3) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (2) shall be issued on payment of the charge shown in column 7 of the Schedule and shall be displayed in a conspicuous position on the windscreen of the vehicle in respect of which it was issued.

6. The following shall be substituted for Article 10 of the Original Order:

PERMIT PARKING

- 10. (1) This Article applies to the Parking Permit Parking Places Places.
 - (a) Subject to availability, the Council may issue a Parking Permit for use in accordance with the Provisions of this Order;
 - (b) The issue of a Parking Permit under paragraph (a) shall be at the Council's discretion;
 - (c) The Driver of a vehicle shall on arrival of the vehicle at a Parking Place exhibit a Parking Permit on the vehicle;
 - (d) The Council reserves the right at any time to withdraw a Parking Permit issued under this paragraph;
 - (e) The Driver of a vehicle shall ensure that any Parking Permit exhibited on his vehicle has been purchased and issued in respect of the period for which it is being used;
 - (f) When a vehicle has left a Parking Place after waiting there for a period which does not exceed the Maximum Waiting Period and displaying a Parking Permit the Driver shall not within one hour of its leaving cause or permit it to wait again upon the Parking Place; and
 - (g) The Driver of a vehicle shall not allow the vehicle to wait continuously in a Parking Place for longer than the Maximum Waiting Period.
 - (2) This paragraph applies to the Parking Place, or part thereof, in category G of the Schedule, namely, Lower Street Pulborough.
 - (a) Subject to availability, on payment of the Annual Fee a business operating in Pulborough ('the Business') may purchase a Parking Permit for use in accordance with the provisions of this Order;
 - (b) The Driver of a vehicle may on arrival of the vehicle at a Parking Place exhibit a Parking Permit on the vehicle;

- (c) The Driver of a vehicle shall ensure that any Parking Permit exhibited on his vehicle has been purchased and issued:-
 - (i) in respect of the period for which it is being used; and
 - (ii) in respect of the Business that is that Driver's place of work;
- (d) When a vehicle has left a Parking Place after waiting there for a period which does not exceed the Maximum Waiting Period and displaying a Parking Permit the Driver shall not within one hour of its leaving cause or permit it to wait again upon the Parking Place; and
- (e) The Driver of a vehicle shall not allow the vehicle to wait continuously in a Parking Place for longer than the Maximum Waiting Period.
- (3) A Parking Permit issued in accordance with paragraphs (1) or (2) above shall be exhibited on the vehicle
- (a) in the case of a two wheeled motor cycle, having a sidecar attached thereto, or an invalid carriage, so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle; or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle which is fitted with a transparent windscreen by placing the Parking Permit near to the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle; or
- in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen by placing the Parking Permit on the front of the vehicle facing forwards not more than 2 metres and not less than 750 millimetres above the surface of the Parking Place.
- (4) In the event of a contravention of Article 10(1)(f), 10(1)(g), 10(2)(d) or 10(2)(e) it shall be assumed, unless the contrary is shown, that the Parking Permit mentioned in those paragraphs is an approved device and obtained from the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council.

VOUCHER PARKING

- This Article (and Articles 8, 9 of this Order and 14(1)) of the Original Order) apply to the Voucher Parking Parking Places;
 - The Driver of a vehicle shall on the arrival of the vehicle at such a Parking Place during the Voucher Parking Hours exhibit on the vehicle in accordance with the following provisions of this Order a Parking Voucher or Vouchers;
 - (3) The Parking Voucher or Vouchers shall be exhibited on the vehicle:-
 - (a) in the case of a two wheeled motor cycle, having a sidecar attached thereto, or an invalid carriage, so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle;
 - (b) in the case of a vehicle which is fitted with a transparent windscreen by placing the Parking Voucher near to the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle; or
 - in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen by placing the Parking Voucher on the front of the vehicle facing forwards not more than 2 metres and not less than 750 millimetres above the surface of the parking place

and so that the date and time of arrival at such Parking Place are shown on the front of the Parking Voucher or Vouchers and can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle.

- 8. (1) The Driver of a vehicle shall upon exhibiting the Parking Voucher or Vouchers on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 exhibit Parking Vouchers sufficient in value for the fee appropriate to the length of stay at such Parking Place;
 - (2) The Driver of a vehicle shall not allow the vehicle to wait continuously in such a Parking Place during the Voucher Parking Hours for longer than the applicable period specified in column 6 of the Schedule; and
 - (3) In respect of any contravention of Articles 8(1) and (2) it shall be assumed, unless the contrary is shown, that the Parking Voucher is an approved device and obtained from the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council.

- When a vehicle has left such a Parking Place after waiting thereon and displaying a Parking Voucher or Vouchers the Driver shall not within one hour after its leaving cause or permit it to wait again upon that Parking Place.
- 10. The following shall be substituted for Article 14 of the Original Order:

LIABILITY TO PENALTY CHARGE AT PARKING PLACES

- 14. (1) In the case of a Parking Disc Parking Place, a Voucher Parking Parking Place or a Parking Permit Parking Place the Driver of a vehicle shall be in contravention of this Order (subject to Article 14 hereof) if:
 - the vehicle is left in such a Parking Place during the Parking Disc Hours or Voucher Parking Hours without a Parking Disc, Parking Voucher or an appropriate Parking Permit as the case may be;
 - (b) he knowingly exhibits on any vehicle any Parking Disc, Parking Voucher or Parking Permit which has been defaced mutilated copied or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible;
 - (c) the vehicle is allowed to wait continuously in a Parking Place:-
 - (i) during the Parking Disc Hours or the Voucher Parking
 Hours whilst displaying a Parking Disc or a Parking
 Voucher for longer than the applicable period specified in
 Column 6 of the Schedule as prohibited by Article 12(2) of
 the Original Order or Article 8(2) of this Order; or
 - (ii) whilst displaying an appropriate Parking Permit for longer than the Maximum Waiting Period as prohibited by Article 10(1)(g) or 10(2)(e);
 - (d) he allows a vehicle displaying:-
 - (i) a Parking Disc or a Parking Voucher to return to the same Parking Place during the Parking Disc Hours or the Parking Voucher Hours within one hour after leaving and causes or permits it to wait again in that Parking Place as prohibited by Article 13 of the Original Order or Article 9 of this Order; or
 - (ii) a Parking Permit to return to the same Parking Place after expiry of the Maximum Waiting Period within one hour after

leaving and causes or permits it to wait again in that Parking Place as prohibited by Article 10(1)(f) or Article 10(2)(d);

- after the Parking Disc exhibited on the vehicle has been set in accordance with Article 12(1), the driver alters the Parking Disc whilst the said vehicle remains in the Parking Place;
- upon exhibiting a Parking Disc on the vehicle the driver fails to set the Parking Disc so that it indicates the time of arrival in accordance with the provisions of Article 12(1), or upon exhibiting a Parking Voucher on the vehicle the driver fails to indicate thereon the date and time of arrival at the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of Article 7(3)

and (without prejudice to the Council's rights contained in the Act of 1984) a penalty charge calculated in accordance with Article 14(10) ('Penalty Charge') shall be payable;

- (2) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place during the charging hours for longer than the initial period for which payment was made a Penalty Charge shall be payable;
- (3) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place during the charging hours where no initial payment has been made in accordance with Article 8(3) or 9(2) then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;
- (4) If a vehicle is parked wholly or partly in a designated Parking Place that is not:-
- (a) designated for that vehicle, or
- (b) designated for the driver of that vehicle; or
- (c) designated for use by an organisation to which the driver or the car belongs;

then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;

(5) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place for a period which exceeds the maximum period of waiting for that Parking Place as specified in column 6 of the Schedule then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;

- (6) If a vehicle having left a Parking Place after waiting thereon then returns to that Parking Place in contravention of any limit on so doing as specified in column 6 of the Schedule then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;
- (7) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in a position other than as authorised by column 2 of the Schedule for that Parking Place then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;
- (8) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place and that vehicle is of a class which is not authorised by column 3 of the Schedule to wait in that Parking Place then a Penalty Charge shall be payable;
- (9) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place and that vehicle is thereon used for a purpose which is prohibited by Article 5 and/or Article 6 of this (the Original) Order then a Penalty Charge shall be payable; and
- (10) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a Car Park Attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Penalty Charge Notice.

EXEMPTION

- 11. Part III of the Original Order shall be deleted.
- 12. (1) The driver of a vehicle, being either the holder of a Disabled Person's Badge or the driver of a vehicle in which the holder of a Disabled Person's Badge is at that time a passenger, which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's badge shall be exempt from any payment specified in Articles 8, 9 and 14(1) to (9) PROVIDED THAT the holder of the Disabled Person's Badge is exempt from paying Vehicle Excise Duty in respect of that vehicle by reason of the fact that he or she is in receipt of the higher rate of the mobility component of Disability Living Allowance;
 - (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position when -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited there on with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.
- A Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and which is left in a Parking Disc Parking Place during the Parking Disc Hours or in a Voucher Parking Parking Place during the Parking Voucher Hours shall be exempt from compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in such a Parking Place specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order PROVIDED THAT the holder of the Disabled Person's Badge is exempt from paying Vehicle Excise Duty in respect of that vehicle by reason of the fact that he or she is in receipt of the higher rate of the mobility component of Disability Living Allowance.
- 14. The Driver of a vehicle waiting in a Parking Disc Parking Place or in a Voucher Parking Parking Place between the period 1800 hours and 0900 hours the following morning of all day on Sundays shall (during these periods only) be exempt from exhibiting a Parking Disc or a Parking Voucher and shall be exempt from any limitation of time specified in Column 6 of the Schedule applicable to those Parking Places PROVIDED THAT he or she is exempt from paying Vehicle Excise Duty in respect of that vehicle by reason of the fact that he or she is in receipt of the higher rate of the mobility component of Disability Living Allowance.

REVOCATION

15. The First Amendment Order and the Second Amendment Order shall be revoked.
