## THE BOROUGH OF WORTHING (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2007 (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2009

The Council of The Borough of Worthing (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of West Sussex County Council and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

#### Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 2009 and may be cited as The Borough of Worthing (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2009.

#### Effect of the Order

- The Borough of Worthing (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order
   2007 shall have effect as though:-
  - a. The definition of "permit" was amended to read:
     "permit" means any document issued by the Council (including a residents permit and visitor permit) allowing a vehicle to be parked in a specific parking place and a permit may specify conditions of use;
  - b. A further definition was added as follows: "designated parking area" means, in respect of the parking place known as Amelia Park, the paved carriageway areas including the marked parking bays as shown on Plan No. 0910/29207.001/01. For the avoidance of doubt, all un-surfaced areas of grass, footpaths as well as footways protected by a kerb are not included in any designated parking area;

#### c. Article 7 was amended to read:

#### Class and position of vehicle

Where in the Schedules a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or vehicles are to be left in a specified location, no person shall permit a vehicle to wait in that parking place or in any parking bay within the parking place,


- (i) unless it is of the specified class;
- (ii) unless it is wholly within a marked parking bay or, in the parking place known as Amelia Park, wholly within a designated parking area; or
- (iii) in a position other than that specified.
- d. Article 35 was amended to read:

#### Residents permits

Permits may be issued to residents in the properties situated in Park Crescent to allow a vehicle displaying such a permit to be left in the designated parking area in the parking place known as Amelia Park; the permit to be subject to such charge and conditions as determined from time to time by the Council.

For the avoidance of doubt, vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge must also display a valid permit.

- e. Schedule 3 was revoked and replaced by Schedule 3 (Amended)
- f. In respect of the parking place known as Amelia Park,
  - The extent of the parking place is as shown on Plan Number 0910/29207.001/01 attached to this Order,
  - ii. The designated parking areas are as shown on Plan Number
