

**THE BOROUGH OF WORTHING (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT no. 3) ORDER 2012**

The Council of The Borough of Worthing (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, with the consent of West Sussex County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

1. The Order shall come into operation on 1 July 2012 and may be cited as "The Borough of Worthing (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.3) Order 2012. The Order amends The Borough of Worthing (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007 (the 2007 Order).

Effect of the Order

The Order shall have the effect as follows:

- A. Further definitions added to the 2007 Order as follows:

"Coach" means a chartered or long distance bus which is constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 seated passengers in addition to the driver which is not operating a scheduled local service.

"Coach Bays" means a bay designed for the use by coaches in order for passengers to board or alight.

"Collecting" means in relation to any "goods vehicle" includes any goods being checked for the purpose of their collection.

"Council Pool Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle provided by the Councils ("Councils" means Adur District Council or Worthing Borough Council) for the sole use of persons in the execution of their duties on the Councils business.

"Deliver" in relation to any "goods vehicle" includes any goods being checked for the purpose of their delivery.

"electric vehicle bays" means bays solely designed for the use by plug-in electric vehicles and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles in order to recharge their supply by using the electric plug-in points in the car park.

"plug-in electric vehicle" means an electric drive vehicle using one or more electric motors for propulsion which may also contain a combustion engine either for the exclusive use of supplying energy to recharge the power source and/or supplying motive power.

“plug-in hybrid electric vehicle” means a hybrid vehicle which utilizes rechargeable batteries, or another energy storage device that can be restored to full charge by connecting a plug to an external electric power source.

B. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 2 Pay and Display Parking Places section referring to the Civic Centre to add as follows:

- The eight (8) car parking bays indicated on the attached Civic Centre plan and coloured in red on the plan are reserved for Council pool vehicles users at any time and for an unlimited length of stay. In addition these bays are reserved for vehicles used by visitors to the Council Offices only with a maximum stay of 1 hour with no return on the same calendar date, between the hours of 8.00am -6.00pm Monday to Saturday. For the avoidance of doubt these car parking bays are within the scope of the Civic Centre car park.
- The three (3) car parking bays at the rear of the Assembly Hall as indicated on the attached Civic Centre plan and coloured in blue on the plan are reserved at all times for disabled users displaying a valid Blue badge. For the avoidance of doubt these car parking bays are within the scope of the Civic Centre car park.

C. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 2 Pay and Display Parking Places sections referring to Beach House East and West Car Parks to add as follows:

To replace the current plan of the Beach House Car Parks with a new plan, which is attached, that reflects the expansion of the Beach House Car Parks to include an additional 44 parking bays in the Beach House West car park, and an additional 14 parking bays (this figure includes the drop off bays) in the Beach House East car park.

D. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 2 Pay and Display Parking Places section referring to Beach House East car park to add as follows:

Vehicles (other than coaches) may use the designated drop off point for passengers to board or alight. Maximum stay in the designated area is 10 (ten) minutes.

Coaches may use the designated coach drop off point for passengers to board and alight. Maximum stay in the designated area is 20 (twenty) minutes.

Goods vehicles may use the designated coach drop off point without time limit in order to load or unload goods or burden of any description or to deliver or collect goods providing the activity occurs only in the designated coach drop off point and the activity is constant.

E. Amend the 2007 Order Part IV Exemptions from Daily Charges to add to paragraph 37:

- iv. Goods vehicles using the designated coach drop off point
- v. Vehicles and Coaches using the designated drop off points.
- vi. Council Pool vehicles using the designated bays
- vii. Vehicles used by visitors to the Council Offices using the designated bays

F. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 1 Pay on Foot Parking Places section referring to Buckingham Road Multi-storey car park to add as follows:

Only vehicles of a specified class, for this purpose specified class means plug-in electric vehicles or plug-in hybrid vehicles, may park in the designated electric vehicles bays. For avoidance of doubt there are four (4) designated parking bays, and the vehicles must pay for parking whilst using the electric plug-in charging points.

G. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 1 Pay on Foot Parking Places section referring to Grafton Multi-storey car park to add as follows:

Only vehicles of a specified class, for this purpose specified class means plug-in electric vehicles or plug –in hybrid vehicles, may park in the designated electric vehicles bays. For avoidance of doubt there are four (4) designated parking bays, and the vehicles must pay for parking whilst using the electric plug-in charging points.

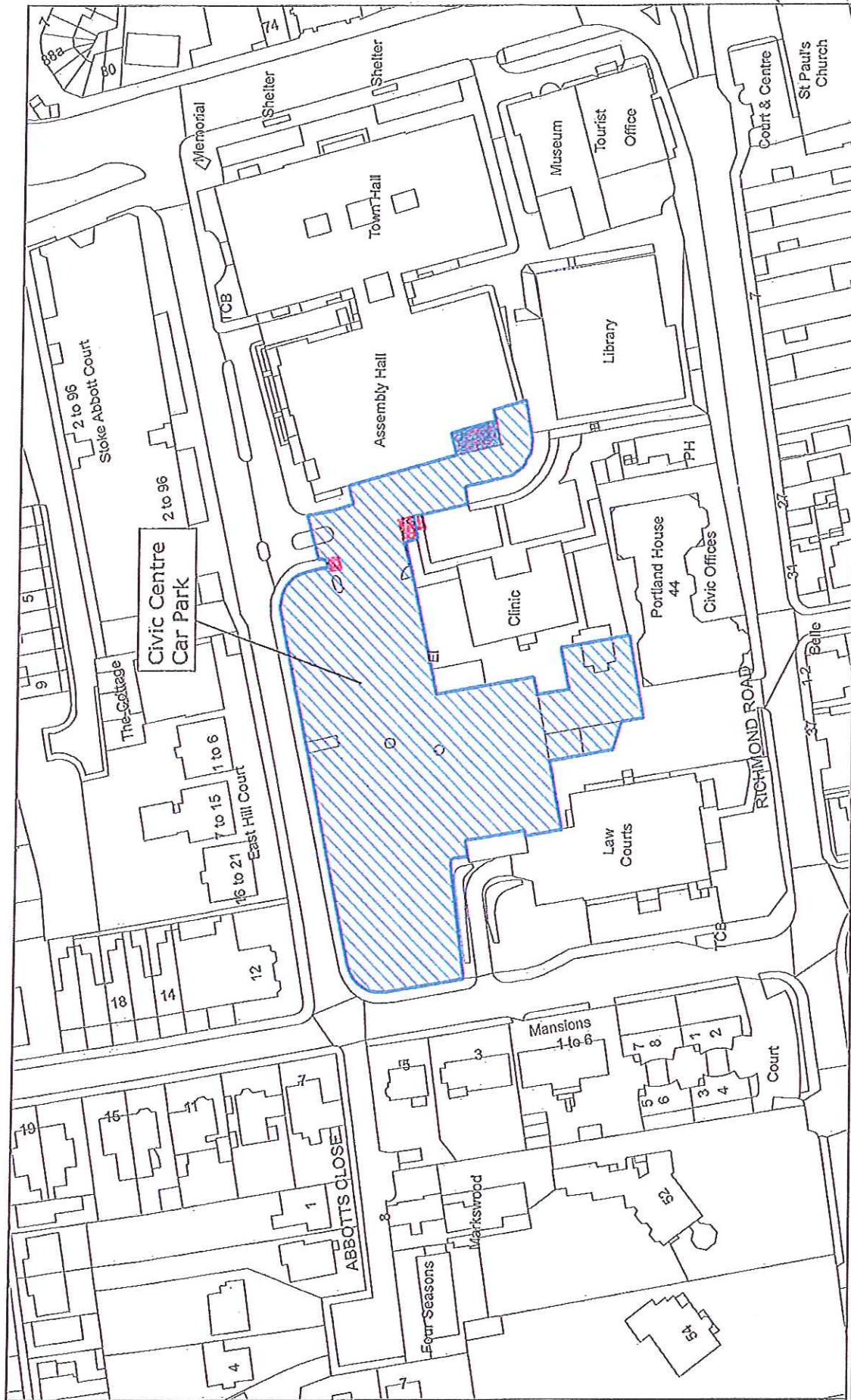
H. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 1 Pay on Foot Parking Places section referring to High Street Multi-storey car park to add as follows:

Only vehicles of a specified class, for this purpose specified class means plug-in electric vehicles or plug –in hybrid vehicles, may park in the designated electric vehicles bays. For avoidance of doubt there are two (2) designated parking bays, and the vehicles must pay for parking whilst using the electric plug-in charging points.

I. Amend the 2007 Order Schedule 2 Pay and Display Parking Places section referring to Brooklands Western Road car park to add as follows:

Only vehicles of a specified class, for this purpose specified class means plug-in electric vehicles or plug-in hybrid vehicles, may park in the designated electric vehicles bays. For avoidance of doubt there are two (2) designated parking bays, and the vehicles must pay for parking whilst using the electric plug-in charging points.

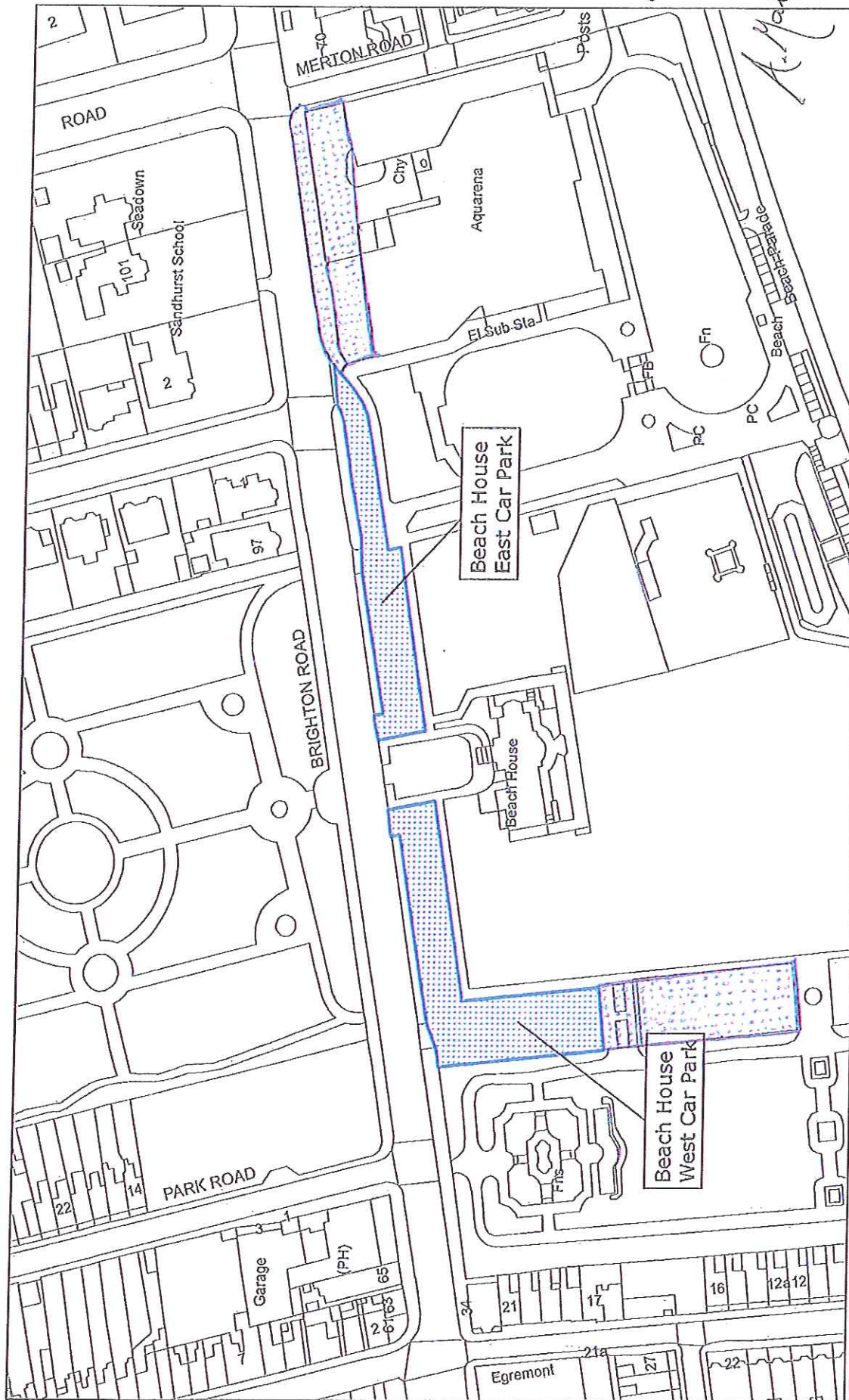
