

**THE HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
GENERAL ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2006**

Horsham District Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act of 1984'), Sections 43 and 63 to 79 inclusive of and Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of West Sussex County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order is supplemental to the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 ('the Original Order').
2. This Order shall take effect on the 4th October 2006 and may be cited as the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No. 2) Order 2006.
3. The Original Order shall have effect:

(i) with regard to the car parks at and known as or to be known as the

Access Road between Park North and the Capitol, North Street,
Horsham;

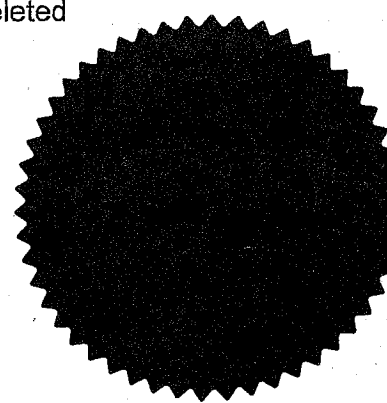
British Telecom Exchange, North Street, Horsham; and

Horsham Park, Albion Way, Horsham (formerly Shelley's Bowling
Centre)

(ii) only for a period of six months from the date on which this Order takes effect, as if Clause 20 (Part III) of the Original Order were deleted therefrom.
