

**THE HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
GENERAL ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER 2008**

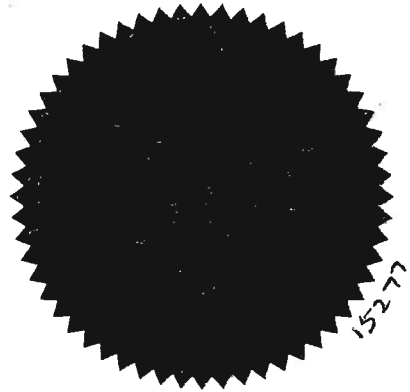
Horsham District Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act of 1984'), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of West Sussex County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order is supplemental to the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 ('the Original Order') and the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No. 3) Order 2008 ('the Third Amendment Order').
2. This Order shall come into operation on the *14th August*, 2008 and may be cited as the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) General Order 2006 (Amendment No. 4) Order 2008.
3. The Third Amendment Order shall have effect and shall be read as if:
 1. That part of Category G of the Schedule to this Order which relates to Billingshurst Leisure Centre car park were added to and included within Category G of the Schedule to the Third Amendment Order;
 2. That part of Category J of the Schedule to this Order which relates to High Street Steyning car park were substituted for the corresponding part of Category J of the Schedule to the Third Amendment Order; and
 3. That part of Category N of the Schedule to this Order which relates to Park House North Street Horsham car park were substituted for the corresponding part of Category N of the Schedule to the Third Amendment Order.

4. **INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITION**

'Civil Enforcement Officer' has the meaning assigned to it by Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
