

**THE MID SUSSEX DISTRICT COUNCIL  
((OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2006)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2011**

The Council of the District of Mid Sussex (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('The Act'), Regulation 21 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, and the Traffic Management Act 2004 whether generally or in relation to the Council's area and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of West Sussex given under Section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police and the Freight Transport Association and the Road Haulage Association in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**PART I**

**GENERAL**

**Commencement & Citation**

1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on **20<sup>th</sup> June 2011** and may be cited as "The Mid Sussex District Council ((Off Street Parking Places) Order 2006) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2011"
- (2) The Mid Sussex District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2006 is hereby amended by the substitution of the Articles in the First Schedule to this Order and the addition of the items in the Second Schedule to this Order.

**Interpretation**

2. (1) Any reference in this Order to 'the Schedule' is a reference to the Schedule in The Mid Sussex District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2006
- (2) as before and including the following definitions:

'parking disc' means an approved device obtained from the Council or other body duly authorised by the Council capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a vehicle arrived at a parking place.

**PART II**

**FIRST SCHEDULE**

**3 Article 6 (4)**

Upon the expiry of a ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Article 4(2) the vehicle shall leave the parking place and shall not return to the parking place during the permitted hours within the no return period shown in that parking place and in respect of the parking places numbered 38, 39, 40 and 41 in column 1 of the Schedule the no return period shall be two hours.

#### 4 Article 28

- (1) This article and Articles 29 and 30 apply only to the parking bays identified in the Schedule to the Order in Trinity Road Car Park, Hurstpierpoint; Orion Car Park, Hassocks; Broad Street Car Park, Cuckfield; The Dolphin, Haywards Heath; The Triangle, Burgess Hill; Kings Centre, East Grinstead and Clair Hall, Haywards Heath.
- (2) The Driver of a vehicle shall on arrival at a parking place and at all times when the vehicle is in the parking place during the hours of operation, exhibit in the vehicle, a parking disc, in a conspicuous position in such a manner that the time of arrival is clearly visible.

#### 5 Article 29

- (1) The Driver shall upon exhibiting the parking disc set the time on the disc so that it indicates the time of arrival, but where the vehicle arrived neither on the hour, or the half hour, the disc must be set to the nearest preceding quarter hour. The time displayed on the disc will be treated as evidence that the vehicle has been waiting in the parking place for longer than the permitted period.
- (2) (a) In respect of parking places numbered 4, 5 and 9 in column 1 of the Schedule, when a vehicle has left a parking place it shall not be permitted to return to that same parking place within one hour of leaving.  
(b) In respect of parking places numbered 34, 35, 36, and 37 in column 1 of the Schedule, when a vehicle has left a parking place it shall not be permitted to return to that same parking place within two hours of leaving
- (3) The Driver shall not permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum time permitted.
