

**The Borough of Worthing (Off- Street Parking Places) (Consolidation Order) 2007.  
(Minor TMA Order No.1) 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Worthing in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of The Road Traffic Regulation 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following order:

**Commencement and Citation**

This Minor Order shall come into operation on 31 May 2022 and may be cited as The Worthing Borough (Off- Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2007 (Minor TMA Order No.1) 2022.

**Effect of the Order**

**Articles to be substituted**

The Minor Order shall have the effect on that any reference in the 2007 Order to The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England), The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on levels of charges) (England) General Regulations 2007 or to “the 2007 regulations” shall now be a reference to The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) (England) Regulations 2022

**Article 2 Interpretation to be substituted to read**

“penalty charge” means a charge imposed by legislation in respect of parking contraventions that are subject to civil enforcement and has the same meaning as in The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) (England) Regulations 2022

“penalty charge notice” means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with Regulations 9 and 10 of The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) (England) Regulations 2022

**Article 56 Interpretation to be substituted to read**

If the PCN is not paid before the end of the 28 days, beginning with the date on which the PCN was served, the Council may serve a Notice to Owner on the registered keeper. If the PCN is not paid by the end of the 28 day period, from the date of the Notice to Owner, the PCN may be increased by 50%. Should the Penalty Charge remain outstanding the Council can pursue the matter as outlined in The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) (England) Regulations 2022 and The Civil Procedure Rules 1998 (as amended), or any replacements or amendments to the same.
