**THE WIGAN BOROUGH(DECriminalISATION OF PARKING)
(WIGAN ROADS)(TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004
(AMENDMENT NO.13) ORDER 2006**

The Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 63(1) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 and Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.13) Order 2006 and shall come into operation on 11th April 2006.
2. The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking)(Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) In relation to Schedule Five, the following entry shall be deleted from Schedule Five to the Order:-

Wallgate, Wigan	Southeast	A point 124 metres north of its junction with Queen Street	A point 52 metres south of its junction with King Street	6.00p.m – 6.00a.m on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. All day on a Sunday

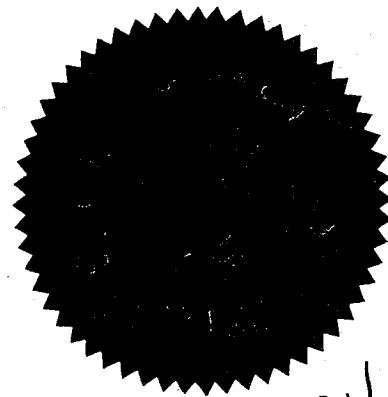
- (b) In relation to Schedule Five, the following entry shall be added to Schedule Five to the Order:-

Wallgate, Wigan	Southeast	A point 124 metres north of its junction with Queen Street	A point 52 metres south of its junction with King Street, Wigan	6.00p.m. – 6.00a.m on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. All day on a Sunday and all Bank Holidays.

3. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments. The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking)(Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 shall remain in force.
