THE WIGAN BOROUGH (AMENDMENT TO CONSOLIDATION ORDERS)  
(PRIVILEGED PARKING PERMITS/DAILY PARKING PERMITS/DAILY BUSINESS  
PARKING PERMITS) ORDER 2006

The Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 45, 46 & 47 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Wigan Borough (Amendment to Consolidation Orders) (Privileged Parking Permits/Daily Parking Permits/Daily Business Parking Permits) Order 2006 and shall come into operation on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2006.
2. The following clause is hereby inserted as part (iv) of the "relevant position" definition in The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No. 2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
  - (iv) A vehicle displays a privileged parking permit in the relevant position if:-
    - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the privileged parking permit is exhibited thereon so that all the particulars shown on the permit are legible from outside the vehicle, or
    - (b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the privileged parking permit is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that all the particulars shown on the permit are legible from outside the vehicle
3. The following paragraph is hereby inserted as Article 33 (c) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No.2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and Article 37 (c) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
  - (c) if the privileged parking permit displayed on the vehicle in the relevant position during the permitted hours is a privileged parking permit issued for a different privileged parking zone. In such circumstances the permit would not be valid for the zone where the vehicle is parked
4. The following paragraphs are hereby inserted as Article 41 (c), (d) & (e) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No. 2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and Article 49 (c), (d) & (e) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004.

- c) Any resident of a dwelling-house adjoining any privileged parking place may apply to the council for the issue of a book of daily parking permits for the leaving of a vehicle which is a passenger vehicle, light goods vehicle or a motorcycle belonging to a person visiting that resident and subject to the other provisions of this Article the council shall issue a book of daily parking permits to such resident. A daily parking permit is only valid for one occasion and no person shall use a daily parking permit for more than one occasion
  - d) Any occupier of a business premises adjoining any privileged parking place may apply to the council for the issue of a book of daily business permits for the leaving of a vehicle which is a passenger vehicle, light goods vehicle or a motorcycle belonging to a person visiting that occupier and subject to the other provisions of this Article the council shall issue a book of daily business parking permits to such occupier. A daily business parking permit is only valid for one occasion and on that occasion for only four hours from commencement of the period of waiting.
  - e) In any respect not specifically mentioned in Paragraphs (c) and (d) of this Article the procedure, validity and terms of use for a daily parking permit or daily business parking permit shall be the same as the procedure, validity and terms of use of a residents privileged parking permit.
5. The following paragraphs are hereby inserted as Article 46 (e) & (f) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking)(Wigan Roads No 2)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking)(Leigh Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 and Article 54 (e) & (f) of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
- e) A daily parking permit shall include the following additional particulars
    - i) the authentication that the daily parking permit has been issued by the council shall include the application number.
    - ii) the day, date and month for which occasion the permit is being used shall be scratched off / crossed off in pen the permit at all times during which a vehicle is left in a privileged parking place during the permitted hours.
  - f) A daily business parking permit shall include the following additional particulars
    - i) the authentication that the daily business parking permit has been issued by the council shall include the application number
    - ii) the day, date and month for which occasion the permit is being used shall be scratched off/crossed off in pen the permit and the time of the commencement of waiting shall be inserted on the permit at all times during which a vehicle is left in a privileged parking place during the permitted hours. (the maximum period of use being four hours)
  - g) The registration mark of the vehicle is not displayed on a daily parking permit or a daily business parking permit

6. The following Article hereby replaces Article 47 of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No.2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004, The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking)(Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004.

Display of Privileged Parking Permits

47. At all times during which a vehicle is left in a privileged parking place during the permitted hours there shall be displayed in the relevant position a valid privileged parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle so that all the particulars referred in Article 46 of this Order are readily visible from outside the vehicle

7. The following Article hereby replaces Article 55 of The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004.

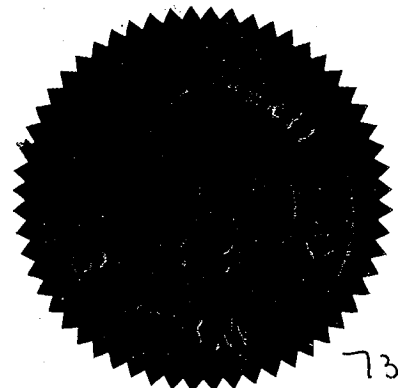
Display of Privileged Parking Permits

55. At all times during which a vehicle is left in a privileged parking place during the permitted hours there shall be displayed in the relevant position a valid privileged parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle so that all the particulars referred in Article 54 of this Order are readily visible from outside the vehicle
8. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments the following Orders shall remain in force
- i) The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No.2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
  - ii) The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
  - iii) The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
  - iv) The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004
