THE WIGAN BOROUGH(DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING) (WIGAN ROADS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004 (AMENDMENT NO. 26) ORDER 2007

The Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991, hereby makes the following Order -

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 26) Order 2007 and shall come into operation on 27th August 2007.
- 2. The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) In relation to Schedule Seven, the following entries shall be deleted from Schedule Seven to the Order:-

Douglas Road, Wigan	North	A point 25 metres east of its junction with Wigan Lane	Its eastern end	On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 9.00 am – 5.00pm
Douglas Road, Wigan	South	A point 25 metres east of its junction with Wigan Lane	Its eastern end	On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 9.00 am – 5.00pm

(b) In relation to Schedule Seven, the following entry shall be added to Schedule Seven to the Order:-

Douglas Road, Both Wigan	A point 25 metres east of its junction With Wigan Lane		On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 9.00 am – 5.00pm

3. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments The Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 shall remain in force.
