WIGAN BOROUGH(DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING) (LEIGH ROADS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004 (AMENDMENT NO.54) ORDER 2011

Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby makes the following Order

- This Order may be cited as the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.54) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 2nd January 2012.
- 2. Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (as amended) is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) In relation to Schedule One, Prohibition of Waiting at any time, the following entry shall be deleted from Schedule One to the Order:-

ROAD	SIDE	FROM	TO
Firs Lane, Leigh	South	a point 8 metres west of its junction with Barker Street	For a distance of 38 metres in a westerley direction
Firs Lane, Leigh	South	A point 10 metres west of its junction with Barker Street	A point 10 metres east of its junction with Barker Street
Barker Street, Leigh	Both	Its juncition with Firs Lane	For a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction

(b) In relation to Schedule One, Prohibition of Waiting at any time, the following entries shall be added to Schedule One to the Order:-

ROAD	SIDE	FROM	TO
Firs Lane, Leigh	South	A point 10 metres east of its junction with Barker Street	A point 10 metres west of the unnamed Street (east side of 185 Firs Lane)

Unnamed Street (East side of 185 Firs Lane), Leigh	Both	Its junction with Firs Lane	A point 10 metres in a southerly direction
Barker Street Leigh	Both	Its junction with Firs Lane	For a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction

3. Save as provided in relation to the above amendments Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads)(Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (as amended) shall remain in force.
