At a Quarterly Meeting of the COUNTY COUNCIL of the ADMINISTRATIVE COUNTY OF WILTS, held at the COUNTY OFFICES, TROWBRIDGE, in the said County, on WEDNESDAY, the Twenty-seventh day of NOVEMBER, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

It is RESOLVED AND ORDERED as follows:-

The County Council of the Administrative County of Wilts in exercise of the powers conferred on them under or by virtue of sub-section (2) of Section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 (4) of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) Subject as hereinafter provided in paragraph (2) hereof and unless he acts upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, no owner, driver or other person in control or in charge of any vehicle (hereinafter referred to as "the owner or driver of a vehicle") shall cause or permit such vehicle to wait on the portion of the Amesburyextending.
  Warminster Road (Route A.344)/from its junction with the Amesbury-Wylye Road (Route A.303) at Stonehenge Bottom/running-westwards to a point where the old Salisbury Dovizos Road crossos it at Winterbourne Stoke Down in the parish of Amesbury in the County of Wilts.

- (2) Nothing in paragraph (1) hereof shall be deemed to prohibit the owner or driver of a vehicle from causing or permitting such vehicle to wait:-
  - (i) for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from such vehicle; or
  - (ii) if such vehicle is being used in connection with building operations or demolitions; the removing of any obstruction to traffic; or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road,

or the laying, alteration or repair in or near to the said road, of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports; provided that such vehicle cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

- (3) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (4) This Order may be cited as the County of Wilts (Traffic Regulations) Order, 1935.
