THE CITY OF NEW SARUM (VARIOUS STREETS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER NO. 1, 1965

THE MAYOR ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF NEW SARUM (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 26 and 27(4) of the Road Traffic Act 1960 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length of road in the second column of the said First Schedule
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any day other than a Sunday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in Part I of the Second Schedule to this Order and between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in Part II of the said Second Schedule.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in Part III of the Second Schedule to this Order.

 4. Nothing in Articles 2 3 6 and 7 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to
- from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary to enable
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any funeral building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction to traffic the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878—
- 5. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle if it
