### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

# THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (CASTLE ROAD AND STRATFORD ROAD, SALISBURY) (BUS STOP CLEARWAYS) ORDER 2000

The Council of the County of Wiltshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a bus operating a registered local service to stop or wait at any time in a bus stop area as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a bus operating a registered local service to stop or wait between the hours of 8.00 am to 9.30 am and 3.00 pm to 4.30 pm on Monday to Friday in a bus stop area as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait in a bus stop area referred to in that Article: -
  - (a) if the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (b) if the vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or gas, water, electricity or telecommunications authority in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in that bus stop area;
  - (c) if the vehicle is being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes; or
  - (d) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle -
    - (i) is required by law to stop;
    - (ii) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident; or

- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restrictions or prohibition, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

#### 5. In this Order: -

"bus stop area" means any area of carriageway of a specified road, intended for the waiting of a bus operating a registered local service which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram 1025.1 or 1025.3 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"bus" has the meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs & General Directions Regulations 1994.

"Registered Local Service" has the meaning as specified in Sections 2 and 6 of the Transport Act 1985.

6. This Order shall come into operation on 27 November 2000 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (Castle Road and Stratford Road, Salisbury) (Bus Stop Clearways) Order 2000.

Stratford Road	North-east	From a point 2m to a point 16m south-east of a point in line with the centreline of Victoria Court (unadopted)
		From a point 5m south-east of a point in line with the boundary between Nos. 8 & 10 Stratford Road for a distance of 19m north-westwards
	South- west	From a point 25m north-west of a point in line with the boundary line between Nos. 10 & 12 Stratford Road to a point 26m south-east of a point in line with the centreline of the vehicular access to South Wilts Grammar School
