**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (HIGH STREET, AMESBURY)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING EXCEPT FOR TAXIS) ORDER 2003**

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended, (whether generally or in relation to the Council's area, or part thereof) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.00 pm and 8.00 am in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a taxi to stop or wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle;
  - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (e) a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated in or adjacent to the said length of road; or
  - (f) in the service of the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in a case of emergency;
  - (g) a vehicle to be loaded or unloaded whilst it is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture and effects from one office or dwelling house to another or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the Police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle:-
- (i) being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (ii) owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when used as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral;
4. Where a vehicle has been left in contravention of the restrictions imposed by this Order, a Penalty Charge shall be incurred, the amount of which will be set by Wiltshire County Council under the provisions of the Act of 1991 relating to special parking areas and permitted parking areas.
5. Where a Penalty Charge is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice shall be issued by a Parking Attendant in accordance with the requirements of the Act of 1991.
6. The Penalty Charge shall be paid within 28 days payable to Salisbury District Council under the terms referred to in the said Notice.
7. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act as amended or by or under any other enactment.
8. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
- "taxi" has the same meaning given by Regulation 4 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994
- "Parking Attendant" has the meaning given by Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

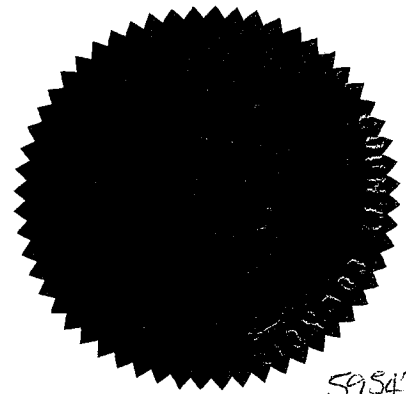
9. This Order shall come into operation on 24 January 2003 and shall be cited as The County of Wiltshire (High Street, Amesbury) (Prohibition of Waiting Except for Taxis) Order 2003.

Prohibition of Waiting 6.00 p.m. to 8.00. a.m.  
(Except for Taxis)

<u>Road</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Description</u>
High Street	South-East	From a point 89 m. south-west of its junction with The Centre to a point 106m. south-west of that junction.
	South-East	From a point 125m. south-west of its junction with The Centre to a point 147m. south-west of that junction.
