**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (MERE) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY)**  
**ORDER 2003**

The Council of the County of Wiltshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(1) and 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended, (whether generally or in relation to the Council's area, or part thereof) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a bus operating a registered local service, a scheduled express service or a school bus, to stop or wait at any time in a bus stop area as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait in a bus stop area referred to in that Article: -
  - (a) if the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (b) if the vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or gas, water, electricity or telecommunications authority in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in that bus stop area;
  - (c) if the vehicle is being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes; or
  - (d) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle -
    - (i) is required by law to stop;
    - (ii) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident; or
    - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
3. Where a vehicle has been left in contravention of the restrictions imposed by this Order, a Penalty Charge shall be incurred, the amount of which will be set by Wiltshire County Council under the provisions of the Act of 1991 relating to special parking areas and permitted parking areas.

4. Where a Penalty Charge is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice shall be issued by a Parking Attendant in accordance with the requirements of the Act of 1991.
5. The Penalty Charge shall be paid within 28 days payable to Salisbury District Council under the terms referred to in the said Notice.
6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Acts and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restrictions or prohibition, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
7. In this Order: -

"bus stop area" means any area of carriageway of a specified road, intended for the waiting of a bus operating a registered local service, a scheduled express service or a school bus, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram 1025.1 or 1025.3 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"bus" has the meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"Registered Local Service" has the meaning as specified in Sections 2 and 6 of the Transport Act 1985;

"Parking Attendant" has the meaning given by Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

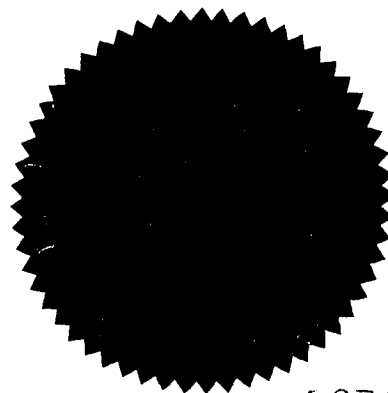
"the Council" means during any period in which there is in force an agreement under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 between the Wiltshire County Council and the Salisbury District Council that the District Council shall administer the Order on the County Council's behalf, the Salisbury District Council failing which it shall mean the Wiltshire County Council.

8. This Order shall come into operation on 17 March 2003 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (Mere) (Bus Stop Clearway) Order 2003.
