# WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SALISBURY – ZONE B) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' PARKING BAY) ORDER 1997 (AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2004

The Council of the County of Wiltshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63A and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended, (whether generally or in relation to the Council's area, or part thereof) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. Wiltshire County Council (Salisbury Zone B) (Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Bay) Order 1997 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1997") shall be further amended by:
  - (a) The addition in the opening paragraph of the Order of 1997 after "4(2)" of "32, 35";
  - (b) The deletion from Article 3(1) of the Order of 1997 of the following interpretation:
    - "formal document" means a document issued by Salisbury District Council to either a resident, business or visitor and includes a permit, waiver or other document issued by that Council to exempt a vehicle from waiting where a restriction applies or from a time limit under the terms and charges applicable at the time"
  - (c) The addition to Article 3(1) of the Order of 1997 of the following interpretations:
    - "waiver document" means a document issued by Salisbury District Council to either a resident business or visitor to exempt a vehicle from waiting where a restriction applies or from a time limit under the terms and charges applicable at the time of issue;"
    - "permit" means a document issued by Salisbury District Council to either a resident or visitor of Zone B to exempt a vehicle from waiting where a restriction applies or from a time limit under the terms and charges applicable at the time of issue;"
  - (d) by the deletion from Article 7 of the Order of 1997 of reference to "Articles 29 and 31" and the replacement of "Articles 10A, 26, 28 and 30A":

- (e) by the addition to Article 8 of the Order of 1997 after the word "Schedule" of "10 and 10A" before "11";
- (f) by the addition in Article 9 of the Order of 1997 after "10" of "10A";
- (g) by the addition to the Order of 1997 of the following Article as Article 9A:-

"Save as provided in Articles 10A, 26, 28 and 30A of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday for a longer period than 30 minutes or if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting of the vehicle in that length of road specified in Schedule 10A to this Order."

- (h) by the deletion from Article 10 of the Order of 1997 of the word "formal document" and the replacement of the word "permit"
- (i) by the addition to the Order of 1997 of the following as Article 10A:-
  - "10A Nothing in Articles 7, 9 and 9A to this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in a parking place (i) during the permitted hours or (ii) for a period longer than 30 minutes if the vehicle is displaying at its front or nearside:
  - (a) a valid waiver document issued by Salisbury District Council
  - (b) a valid British Medical Association badge or other evidence of a medical visit by the local Health Authority personnel, approved by the Salisbury District Council and the visit is for treatment of a patient living nearby"
- (j) by the deletion of Articles 11, 12, 13 and 14 to the Order of 1997 and the replacement of Article 11 as follows:

#### "Application For and Issue of Permits

### 11. (1) Residents' Permits

Any domestic resident whose postal address is in a street or part of a street described in Schedule 12 to this Order and who is the owner of a passenger vehicle, a dual purpose vehicle, light goods vehicle or a motor cycle may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit for the leaving of that vehicle in a designated parking place. Such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the information required by such form.

#### (2) <u>Daily Visitors' Parking Cards</u>

Any domestic resident whose postal address is in a street or part of a street described in Schedule 12 to this Order may apply for daily visitors' parking cards for use on any passenger vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, light goods vehicle or motor cycle belonging to any visitor to that address, for the leaving of that vehicle in a designated parking place. Such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the information required by such form.

#### (3) Annual Visitors' Permit

Any domestic resident over sixty years of age whose postal address is in a street or part of a street described in Schedule 12 to this Order to which no permit has been issued, may apply to the Council for a visitors' permit for use on any passenger vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, light goods vehicle or motor cycle belonging to any visitor to that address, for the leaving of that vehicle in a designated parking place. Such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the information required by such form. Such permits shall be valid for a period of one year. "

- (k) by the deletion of Article 16 to the Order of 1997;
- (I) by the deletion of Article 18 to the Order of 1997 and the replacement of Article 18 as follows:

### "18. Display of Permits and Waivers

- (a) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours under Article 9 of this Order there shall be displayed on the front or near-side of the vehicle a valid permit issued in respect of that vehicle by Salisbury District Council so that all the particulars specified by Salisbury District Council are clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle;
- (b) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a parking place for longer than 30 minutes under Articles 7 and 9A of this Order there shall be displayed on the front or nearside of the vehicle a valid waiver issued in respect of that vehicle by Salisbury District Council so that all the particulars specified by Salisbury District Council are clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle";
- (m) by the deletion of Article 19 of the Order of 1997 and the replacement of Article 19 as follows:

#### "19. Restriction on the Removal of Permits and Waivers

Where a permit or waiver has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 to this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle shall remove the permit or waiver from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

(n) by the deletion of Article 28(2) of the Order of 1997 and the replacement of the following as Article 28(2):

"Except as provided in the foregoing provisions of this Article and in the provisions of Articles 7, 9, 9A, 10, 10A, 26(4) and 30 of this Order the driver of a vehicle shall not cause or permit the vehicle to wait in a parking place during the hours specified in the Schedules referred to in those Articles."

- (o) by the addition in Article 30A of the Order of 1997 after "Article 7" of "9A";
- (p) by the deletion from the Article headed "Restriction of Waiting of Vehicles in Parking Places" of "(a) a formal document issued by Salisbury District Council":
- (q) by the deletion from Schedule 7 of the Order of 1997 of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (r) by the deletion from Schedule 11 of the Order of 1997 of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order;
- (s) by the addition to Schedule 7 of the Order of 1997 of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order;
- (t) by the addition as Schedule 10A to the Order of 1997 of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- (u) by the addition to Schedule 11 of the Order of 1997 of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Order;
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on 24 May 2004 and may be cited as Wiltshire County Council (Salisbury Zone B) (Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Bay) Order 1997 (Amendment No.4) Order 2004.
