**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACT 2004**

**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (SALISBURY STREET, AMESBURY)**  
**(TAXI RANK CLEARWAYS) ORDER 2008**

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a taxi to stop or wait at any time in a taxi rank as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait in a taxi rank for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation, or the maintenance or improvement or reconstruction of the road or any works connected with any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
  - (c) the vehicle to be used in the service of the Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Ambulance Service; or
  - (d) the vehicle to be used in any case where the person in control of the vehicle -
    - (i) is required by law to stop or wait or is permitted to stop or wait by a Police Constable in uniform;
    - (ii) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident; or
    - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
3. Where a vehicle has been left in contravention of the restrictions imposed by this Order, a Penalty Charge shall be incurred, the amount of which will be set by Wiltshire County Council under the provisions of the Act of 2004 relating to the Civil Enforcement Areas and Special Enforcement Areas.

4. Where a Penalty Charge is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice shall be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the Act of 2004.
5. The Penalty Charge shall be paid within 28 days payable to Salisbury District Council under the terms referred to in the said Notice.
6. Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 2004, no person not being the driver of the vehicle or duly authorised representative of the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.
7. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Acts and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restrictions or prohibition, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
8. In this Order:-  
  
"taxi" has the same meaning given by Regulation 4 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and "taxi rank" means an area of carriageway specified in the Schedule hereto, reserved for use by taxis waiting to pick up passengers.  
  
"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the meaning defined in Article 76(1) of the Act of 2004.
9. This Order shall come into operation on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2008 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (Salisbury Street, Amesbury) (Taxi Rank Clearways) Order 2008.


## SCHEDULE

### Taxi Rank Clearway operating at All Times

<u>Road</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Description</u>
Salisbury Street	North-east	From a point 76 metres south east of the boundary of numbers 3 and 5 Salisbury Street for a distance of 12 metres in a south easterly direction
	South-west	From a point opposite a point 95 metres south east of the boundary of numbers 3 and 5 Salisbury Street for a distance of 21 metres in a south easterly direction
		From a point opposite a point 130 metres east of the boundary of numbers 3 and 5 Salisbury Street for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction
