THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, MERE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2009

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

- The County of Wiltshire (Various Roads, Mere) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2003 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 2003") shall be further amended by:-
 - (a) The addition to Schedule 1 of the Order of 2003 of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order will come into operation on 30th January 2009 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (Various Roads, Mere) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2003 (Amendment No.2) Order 2009.

Castle Street (B3095)	North west	From its junction with Castle Hill Lane to a point 10 metres south west of the boundary between the properties known as Bristow House and Glendene
	North west	From a point 20 metres north east of the boundary between the properties known as Bristow House and Glendene to a point 33 metres north east of the boundary between the properties known as Bristow House and Glendene
	North west	From a point in line with the boundary between the properties known as The Cottage and Butcombe to a point 39 metres north east of the boundary between the properties known as The Cottage and Butcombe

South east

From the north eastern boundary of the property known as Glendon to a point 50 metres west of its junction with Barton Lane
