#### STATEMENT OF REASONS

## Woking Borough Council (Woking Park) (Off Street Parking Places) Amendment Order No. 3 2015

- 1. The amendments to the car parks serving the park, Leisure Centre, Pool in the Park and community buildings are proposed to optimise parking facilities following the construction of the temporary Hoe Valley School from September 2015.
- 2. Car Park 1 to close to accommodate the temporary school buildings.
- 3. Car Park 2 restrictions to include drop off facility, permit holder parking 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday with general parking access at other times.
- 4. Car Park 10 reserved for coach parking and permitted loading and unloading as agreed by Parking Services.

- (b) By the deletion of Schedule I of the 2005 Order (as amended) and to include Schedule I contained in the Schedule 1 to this Order and the said Schedule I shall be read as being Schedule I to the 2008 Order; and
- (c) Drawing No. 562/02/REVPI shall be removed from Schedule III of the 2005 Order and Schedule 2 to this Order containing Drawing No. ET-WP-130515 shall be inserted and read as being Schedule III to the 2005 Order (as amended).
