THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILLY WRIGHT CLOSE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2007

The Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of June 2007 and may be cited as the Wolverhampton City Council (Billy Wright Close) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2007

GENERAL

2. (1) In this Order -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No 4631:1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -

- (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle; and

- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
 - (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00am and 9.30am and 2.00pm to 4.30pm on any day other than Saturday or Sunday in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 hereto shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from any vehicle;
 - (ii) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (iii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road;
 - (v) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on the land adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipes or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (vi) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(vii) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;

(viii) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes

5. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the road referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same of length of road on the same day)

both sides, from a point 15 metres south east of its junction with Warstones Road south eastward for a distance of 40 metres including its cul-de-sac end

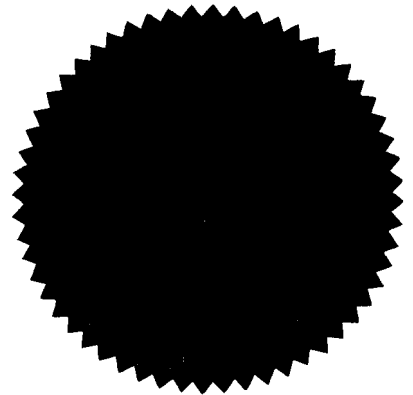
