

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CLEVELAND STREET)

(DESIGNATED LOADING BAY) ORDER 2008

The Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of the powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the *30th May 2008* and may be cited as the Wolverhampton City Council (Cleveland Street) (Designated Loading Bay) Order 2008.
2. "Plans" means the plans referred to in The Wolverhampton City Council (City Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) Order 2007.
3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the side of length of road specified the in Schedule hereto between the hours of 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday unless such waiting is necessary to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle.
4. The Wolverhampton City Council (City Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) Order 2007 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto were deleted and removed from the Plans.
