THE WYCHAVON DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2024

WYCHAVON DISTRICT COUNCIL, in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of Worcestershire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of February 2024 and may be cited as the Wychavon District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Variation No. 2) Order 2024
- 2. The Wychavon District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (the Order), as amended by The Wychavon District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Variation No.1) Order 2023, is hereby varied by:-
 - 1. To amend Schedule 1 of the Order in respect of the Merstow Green Short Stay Car Park, Evesham to provide free parking for users of new motorcycle bays, as shown on the annexed plan.
 - 2. The provision of the new plan annexed hereto in respect of the Pershore, Civic Centre Visitors' Car Park to show the new layout of parking bays
 - 3. The provision of a new plan for the Pershore, Civic Centre Long Stay Car Parks to show the new parking bays on the access road for ambulances and disabled parking and add those to Schedule 1.
 - 4. In respect of the Pershore, Lower Priest Lane Car Park, to amend Schedule 1 to provide free parking for the public on Saturdays limited to 3 hours.
 - 5. To amend Schedule 1 of the Order in respect of the Friar Street Long Stay Car Park, Droitwich to provide free parking for users of new motorcycle bays, as shown on the annexed plan.
